FLOOR SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to nuisance wildlife; authorizing
certain persons to hunt prairie dogs without a
permit; providing for codification; and providing an
effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 4-135.2 of Title 29, unless
there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A private property landowner, lessee, immediate family or
household member thereof or the landowner's or lessee's designated
agent who is a resident of this state may control nuisance or damage
by prairie dogs without a permit by hunting such rodents during the
day to protect marketable agricultural crops, land or processed

1 feed, seed or other materials used in the production of an
2 agricultural commodity.

3 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2021.
