14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
15	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
16	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1737 of Title 69, unless there
17	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
18	The Oklahoma Turnpike Authority shall prepare a report
19	concerning the proposed construction of the South Extension
20	Turnpike. The study shall include, but not be limited to, the
21	following information:
22	1. The factors that were considered when determining the route
23	of the South Extension Turnpike;
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2. Whether the proposed route was determined to be the most
 effective route regarding the flow of traffic and a discussion as to
 the factors considered in making that determination;

3. The specific impact and effect that the planned route will
have on businesses, citizens, and private and public property where
the planned route will be implemented;

7 4. Whether any alternate routes were considered by the Oklahoma
8 Turnpike Authority and the factors considered as to why the
9 alternate routes were not chosen for the South Extension Turnpike;
10 and

5. Any other factors relevant to the decision of the location
of the South Extension Turnpike considered by the Oklahoma Turnpike
Authority.

The Oklahoma Turnpike Authority shall deliver two copies of the 14 report to the Governor, President Pro Tempore of the Senate, and the 15 Speaker of the House of Representatives at least one hundred and 16 eighty (180) days prior to issuing bonds for the construction on the 17 South Extension Turnpike. Upon receipt of the report, the President 18 Pro Tempore of the Senate shall submit one copy of the report to the 19 Chairman of the Senate Transportation Committee, or successor 20 committee. The Speaker of the House of Representatives shall submit 21 one copy of the report to the Chairman of the House Transportation 22 Committee, or successor committee. 23

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1	Upon the receipt of the report the Legislature may modify the
2	authorization for construction or location of the South Extension
3	Turnpike as provided in Section 1732 of Title 69 of the Oklahoma
4	Statutes.
5	SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
6	of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
7	declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
8	be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
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
