FLOOR SUBSTITUTE

[memorial bridge and highway designations -
codification - noncodification - effective date]

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.308 of Title 69, unless
there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The section of U.S. Highway 64 beginning at the western
municipal limits of the town of Buffalo in Harper County extending
to N1860 Road shall be designated as the "William Charles 'Charley'
Coen Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall
cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on
the highway.

1 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
2 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.309 of Title 69, unless
3 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

4 The bridge over Turkey Creek in Woodward County approximately
5 two (2) miles east of the Ellis and Woodward County border on
6 Highway 15 shall be designated as the "Bud Martin Memorial Bridge".
7 The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent
8 markers bearing that name to be placed on the bridge.

9 SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
10 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.310 of Title 69, unless
11 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

12 The bridge over the Cimarron River on Highway 15 approximately
13 thirteen (13) miles north of Boise City shall be designated as the
14 "Private Robert 'Bob' Clark Memorial Bridge". The Department of
15 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that
16 name to be placed on the bridge.

17 SECTION 4. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
18 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.311 of Title 69, unless
19 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

20 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the section of State
21 Highway 287 beginning at the municipal limits of Boise City
22 extending southeast to the Oklahoma-Texas border in Cimarron County
23 shall be designated as the "President Donald J. Trump Highway". The
24

1 Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers
2 bearing that name to be placed on the highway.

3 SECTION 5. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
4 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

5 The cost associated with signage related to Section 4 of this
6 act shall be paid by the Senate and House of Representatives authors
7 and coauthors of this act.

8 SECTION 6. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
9 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.312 of Title 69, unless
10 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

11 The section of State Highway 17 beginning at the east municipal
12 limits of Elgin extending to the intersection with NE Miller Street
13 in Comanche County shall be designated as the "Speaker Pro Tempore
14 Jim R. Glover Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation
15 shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be
16 placed on the highway.

17 SECTION 7. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
18 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.313 of Title 69, unless
19 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

20 The bridge over Western Avenue on Interstate 240 within the
21 municipal limits of Oklahoma City shall be designated as the "Medal
22 of Honor Recipient Sergeant John R. Crews Memorial Bridge". The
23 Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers
24 bearing that name to be placed on the bridge.

1 SECTION 8. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
2 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.314 of Title 69, unless
3 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

4 The portion of State Highway 271 beginning south of the
5 municipal limits of Hugo and ending north of the municipal limits of
6 Grant shall be designated as the "Trooper J.C. Magar Memorial
7 Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable
8 permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the highway.

9 SECTION 9. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
10 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.315 of Title 69, unless
11 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

12 The bridge over Coal Creek located on US Route 75 Business
13 within the municipal limits of Henryetta shall be designated as the
14 "Congressional Medal of Honor Recipient Edward A. DeVore, Jr.
15 Memorial Bridge". The Department of Transportation shall cause
16 suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the
17 bridge.

18 SECTION 10. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
19 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.316 of Title 69, unless
20 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

21 The portion of State Highway 56 beginning just west of North
22 Wood Drive extending approximately one (1) mile west through the
23 municipal limits of Okmulgee shall be designated as the "Navy Cross
24 Recipient CPL Russell Keck Memorial Highway". The Department of

1 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that
2 name to be placed on the highway.

3 SECTION 11. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
4 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.317 of Title 69, unless
5 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

6 The section of State Highway 20 beginning at the junction of
7 State Highway 20 and N 145th E Avenue in Owasso extending east to
8 the junction of State Highway 20 and S 4080 Road in Rogers County
9 shall be designated as the "TSgt Marshal D. Roberts Memorial
10 Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable
11 permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the highway.

12 SECTION 12. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.318 of Title 69, unless
14 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

15 The section of State Highway 30 beginning at the southern
16 municipal limits of the town of Sweetwater in Beckham County
17 extending south to the intersection of State Highway 30 and County
18 Road 1140 in Beckham County shall be designated as the "Sweetwater
19 Veterans Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall
20 cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on
21 the highway.

22 SECTION 13. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
23 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.319 of Title 69, unless
24 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

1 The bridge over Interstate 35 on State Highway 74 within the
2 municipal limits of Purcell in McClain County shall be designated as
3 the "SSGT Cecil Wellman Memorial Bridge". The Department of
4 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that
5 name to be placed on the bridge.

6 SECTION 14. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
7 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.320 of Title 69, unless
8 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

9 The bridge over Little Skin Bayou on U.S. Highway 64 in Sequoyah
10 County shall be designated as the "Officer Michael Bruce Keen
11 Memorial Bridge". The Department of Transportation shall cause
12 suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the
13 bridge.

14 SECTION 15. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.321 of Title 69, unless
16 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 The bridge over Chouteau Creek on U.S. Highway 77 in Cleveland
18 County shall be designated as the "Tommy Wayne Haley Memorial
19 Bridge". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable
20 permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the bridge.

21 SECTION 16. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
22 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.322 of Title 69, unless
23 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

1 The bridge located on Interstate 44 over State Highway 49 within
2 Comanche County shall be designated the "MSGT Michael Werdehoff
3 Vietnam MIA Memorial Bridge". The Department of Transportation
4 shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be
5 placed on the bridge.

6 SECTION 17. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
7 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.323 of Title 69, unless
8 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

9 The portion of State Highway 30 beginning at the northern
10 municipal limits of the town of Sweetwater extending north to the
11 intersection of State Highway 30 and E 1060 Road in Roger Mills
12 County shall be designated as the "SP4 Alfred Dean Hildebrand
13 Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause
14 suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the
15 highway.

16 SECTION 18. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
17 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.324 of Title 69, unless
18 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

19 The bridge located on State Highway 34 over the Salt Fork of the
20 Red River, south of Mangum, in Greer County shall be designated the
21 "James Amos Callins Memorial Bridge". The Department of
22 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that
23 name to be placed on the bridge.
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1 SECTION 19. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
2 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.325 of Title 69, unless
3 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

4 The portion of State Highway 51B beginning one half mile west of
5 the western municipal limits of Porter and ending one half mile east
6 of the eastern municipal limits of Porter shall be designated as the
7 "Lieutenant Eugene Smith Memorial Highway". The Department of
8 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that
9 name to be placed on the highway.

10 SECTION 20. This act shall become effective November 1, 2021.
