15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:		
16	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 26 O.S. 2011, Section 7-108, is		
17	amended to read as follows:		
18	Section 7-108. A. No person shall be allowed to electioneer		
19	within three hundred (300) feet of any ballot box the entrance to a		
20	polling place or in-person absentee voting site or a person who is		
21	standing in line to vote outside the polling place or voting site		
22	while an election is in progress, nor shall any. No person or		
23	persons, except election officials, voters registered and voting at		
24	the polling place or voting site, a minor child or dependent

accompanying such voters and other persons authorized by law₇ shall be allowed inside the election enclosure or within fifty (50) feet of any ballot box the entrance to a polling place or in-person absentee voting site while an election is in progress. No printed material other than that provided by the election board shall be publicly placed or exposed within three hundred (300) feet of any ballot box₇ the entrance to a polling place or in-person absentee voting site while an election is in progress.

- B. For purposes of this title:
- 1. "Electioneering" means:

- a. advocating directly for or against a candidate or question that is on the ballot at the election, either verbally or with visual materials, signs or clothing, or
- b. collecting signatures for a petition to place an issue or question on a future ballot; and
- 2. "Election enclosure" means the areas of a polling place where voters sign the precinct registry and are issued ballots, where voting booths are located, where a voting device or ballot box is located, and any room, hallway or other space wherein such activities take place.
- 22 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 26 O.S. 2011, Section 16-111, is amended to read as follows:
