7 AS INTRODUCED

8 An Act relating to health insurance; defining terms;
9 specifying insurance policies under certain
 circumstances; and providing an effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 8000 of Title 36, unless there
15 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 A. As used in this act:

17 1. "Fertilization" means the fusion of a human spermatozoon
18 with a human ovum.

19 B. All insurers in this state shall recognize fertilization as
20 a qualifying life event, and shall be required to allow for open
21 enrollment into their policies to update that individual's insurance
22 coverage.

1 C. Any insurance provider not complying with this act shall be
2 prohibited from being assigned any state or local contracts for
3 insurance uses.

4 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
