16	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
17	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 19 O.S. 2011, Section 377, is
18	amended to read as follows:
19	Section 377. The board of county commissioners of any county
20	may employ $\frac{1}{2}$ competent information technology (IT) staff and $\frac{1}{2}$ data
21	processing technician $_{m{ au}}$ who shall perform the duties of <u>IT management</u>
22	or data processing management as prescribed and directed by the
23	board of county commissioners , and such data processing technician
24	shall not be employed beyond the term of office of the board of

1	county commissioners employing him. The said IT staff and data
2	processing technician shall receive as compensation a salary
3	salaries to be fixed by the board of county commissioners for his
4	their services, to be paid out of the general operating fund of the
5	county. The compensations of the director and such personnel <u>IT</u>
6	staff and data processing technician shall not be governed by the
7	"Comprehensive Salary Code".
8	The <u>IT staff and</u> data processing technician shall be covered by
9	the county blanket bond.
10	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2021.
