9	An Act relating to waters and water rights; amending
10	82 O.S. 2011, Section 1085.30, as amended by Section 2, Chapter 137, O.S.L. 2018 (82 O.S. Supp. 2020,
11	Section 1085.30), which relates to classification of water uses; requiring the Oklahoma Water Resources
12	Board to propose certain rules; and providing an effective date.
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15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
16	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 82 O.S. 2011, Section 1085.30, as
17	amended by Section 2, Chapter 137, O.S.L. 2018 (82 O.S. Supp. 2020,
18	Section 1085.30), is amended to read as follows:
19	Section 1085.30 A. 1. In order to effectuate a comprehensive
20	program to assist in the prevention, control and abatement of
21	pollution of the waters of this state, and in order to establish
22	state standards which comply with the Federal Water Pollution
23	Control Act as amended, the Oklahoma Water Resources Board is
24	authorized to promulgate rules to be known as "Oklahoma Water

Quality Standards" which establish classifications of uses of waters of the state, criteria to maintain and protect such classifications, and other standards or policies pertaining to the quality of such waters.

5 2. The Oklahoma Water Quality Standards shall, at a minimum, be
6 designed to maintain and protect the quality of the waters of the
7 state.

8 3. Wherever the Board finds it is practical and in the public
9 interest to do so, the rules may be amended to upgrade and improve
10 progressively the quality of waters of the state.

11 4. a. The Board may also amend Oklahoma Water Quality 12 Standards to downgrade a designated use of any waters 13 of this state which is not an existing use, may 14 establish subcategories of a use or may provide for 15 less stringent criteria or other provisions thereof 16 only in those limited circumstances permissible under 17 the Federal Water Pollution Control Act as amended or 18 federal rules which implement the act.

b. The Board may amend the Oklahoma Water Quality
Standards to downgrade a designated use, establish
subcategories of a use or may provide for less
stringent criteria or other provisions thereof only to
the extent as will maintain or improve the existing
uses and the water quality of the water affected;

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1 provided, however, the Board shall not modify the 2 Oklahoma Water Quality Standards applicable to scenic 3 river areas as such areas are described by Section 4 1452 896.5 of this title, to downgrade a designated 5 use, establish a subcategory of a use or provide for less stringent criteria or other provisions thereof. 6 7 The Board shall propose any necessary rules to allow 5. for the development of nutrient trading programs by 8 9 state environmental agencies no later than November 1, 10 2026.

11 Β. 1. Prior to adopting such standards or any amendment 12 thereof, the Board shall conduct public hearings thereon. Notice of 13 such hearing shall be published in accordance with the 14 Administrative Procedures Act and shall be mailed at least twenty 15 (20) days before such public hearing to the chief executive of each 16 municipality and county in the area affected and shall be mailed to 17 all affected holders of permits obtained pursuant to the Oklahoma 18 Environmental Code, and such other persons that have requested 19 notice of hearings on such standard modifications.

20 2. If adoption or amendment of a classification to a lower or
21 downgraded classification is proposed because treatment controls
22 required of the current or a higher or upgraded classification would
23 result in substantial and widespread social and economic impact, the
24 Board shall, in addition to any hearing required by subsection B of

this section, conduct a public meeting within a central location within the area to be affected. The Board shall cause notice of such additional public meeting to be published for at least two (2) consecutive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation published in the county or counties in the area affected.

6 The Oklahoma Water Quality Standards, their accompanying С. 1. 7 use support assessment protocols, anti-degradation policy and implementation, and policies generally affecting Oklahoma Water 8 9 Quality Standards application and implementation including but not 10 limited to mixing zones, low flows and variances or any modification 11 or change thereof shall be promulgated by the Board in compliance 12 with the Administrative Procedures Act and shall be enforced by all 13 state agencies within the scope of their jurisdiction. All use 14 support assessment protocols promulgated by the Board shall be 15 consistent with state and federal law and guidance specifically 16 related to beneficial use support determinations as set forth in 17 Section 305(b) of the Federal Water Pollution Control Act, where 18 applicable.

19 2. In promulgating Oklahoma Water Quality Standards or making 20 any modification or change thereof, the Board shall announce a 21 reasonable time for persons discharging waste into the waters of the 22 state to comply with such new or modified standards unless such 23 discharges create an actual or potential hazard to public health.

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1	3. Any discharge in accord with such standards of the Board and
2	in compliance with rules, requirements and wasteload allocations
3	established by the Department of Environmental Quality and with
4	rules promulgated by other state environmental agencies shall not be
5	deemed to be pollution.
6	4. Notwithstanding the implementation jurisdiction provided to
7	the Board in paragraph 1 of subsection C of this section, the
8	Department of Environmental Quality shall have jurisdiction to
9	develop and utilize policies and requirements, as provided in
10	paragraph 22 of subsection B of Section 1-3-101 of Title 27A of the
11	Oklahoma Statutes.
12	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2021.
