7                   AS INTRODUCED

8           An Act relating to telecommunications; amending 17  
9           O.S. 2011, Section 139.108, which relates to OneNet  
10          and the Oklahoma Government Telecommunications  
11          Network; deleting certain service requirement  
12          restricting Corporation Commission to only use OneNet  
13          as provider; deleting definition; and providing an  
14          effective date.

14   BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15           SECTION 1.        AMENDATORY        17 O.S. 2011, Section 139.108, is  
16   amended to read as follows:

17           Section 139.108.   A.   Except for the provisions of this section,  
18   nothing in this act shall be construed as applicable to the  
19   telecommunications network known as OneNet or to any other component  
20   of the Oklahoma Government Telecommunications Network.   Neither  
21   OneNet nor any other component of the Oklahoma Government  
22   Telecommunications Network shall be assessed any fee or other charge  
23   for the support of universal service.

1 B. No provider of Internet service or any company providing  
2 telecommunications services or its affiliate or subsidiary, may  
3 price such Internet service in an anticompetitive, discriminatory,  
4 or predatory manner or subsidize the price of Internet service with  
5 revenues received from other services. No governmental agency or  
6 entity using or being eligible to use OneNet facilities may price  
7 such Internet services in an anticompetitive or predatory manner.  
8 Any governmental agency or entity using OneNet facilities is hereby  
9 prohibited from reselling OneNet access directly to the general  
10 public at any nonpublic site. Any company or individual damaged  
11 from a violation of this subsection by a private company or  
12 individual shall be entitled to treble damages. The Attorney  
13 General shall be responsible for bringing an action for violation of  
14 this section against a private company or individual.

15 ~~C. The Corporation Commission shall not approve, endorse,~~  
16 ~~forward or file any application for reimbursement submitted pursuant~~  
17 ~~to subsection (h) of Section 254 of the Communications Act of 1934,~~  
18 ~~as amended, for transmission services requiring a circuit of T-1 or~~  
19 ~~greater capacity unless OneNet is the circuit provider. For~~  
20 ~~purposes of this subsection, "T-1" means a digital, one-million-~~  
21 ~~five-hundred-forty-four-thousand-bit (1.544 Mbit) circuit with~~  
22 ~~capacity sufficient to simultaneously transmit twenty-four (24)~~  
23 ~~voice or data channels at sixty-four thousand bits per second (64~~  
24 ~~Kbits/sec).~~

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2021.
