9                                   COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

10                   An Act relating to revenue and taxation; allowing  
11                   certain vehicle charging stations to qualify for per-  
12                   location credit upon enactment of certain bill and  
13                   until certain date; providing for maximum credits  
14                   used to offset tax; providing for codification; and  
15                   providing an effective date.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17                   SECTION 1.           NEW LAW           A new section of law to be codified  
18                   in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2357.22A of Title 68, unless  
19                   there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

20                   Upon Enrolled House Bill 2234 of the 1st Session of the 58th  
21                   Oklahoma Legislature being signed into law, until January 1, 2023,  
22                   electric vehicle charging stations meeting the provisions of  
23                   subparagraph b of paragraph 3 of subsection B of Section 2357.22 of  
24                   Title 68 of the Oklahoma Statutes may qualify for a per-location  
                    credit of seventy-five percent (75%) of the cost of the qualified

1 clean-burning motor fuel property, pursuant to the provisions of  
2 Section 2357.22 of Title 68 of the Oklahoma Statutes. Provided,  
3 however, the total amount of credits authorized by this section used  
4 to offset tax shall be limited to Five Million Dollars  
5 (\$5,000,000.00).

6 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2021.
