Agritourism activities shall only be engaged in a lawful manner and in compliance with health and safety zoning requirements, as well as health and safety regulations, by the state and local governments.

8 C. "Agritourism activities" as used in this section means 9 utilizing livestock or other animals for entertainment or 10 educational purposes. This shall include horseback riding, horse-11 drawn carriage rides, livestock and other animal shows, petting 12 zoos, rodeos, activities that historically involved the utilization 13 of working animals and other substantially similar activities. 14 SECTION 2.
