Supp. 2020, 16 Section 400), is amended to read as follows: 17 Section 400. A. The Department of Corrections is hereby 18 authorized to establish units at one or more institutions for the 19 care and treatment of inmates who are or become in need of acute 20 psychiatric care. The Department shall have the following powers 21 and duties in the operation thereof: 22 The Department shall establish procedures to outline means 23 of identification of inmates who are or become in need of acute 24 psychiatric care and for assignment of such inmates to the units

1	described in this subsection. Prior to assignment there shall be a
2	due process hearing conducted by the Department of Corrections to
3	determine whether the inmate is in need of acute psychiatric care.
4	The inmate shall be entitled to have a staff representative
5	appointed to represent him or her the inmate, if he or she so
6	requests, but shall not have an attorney appointed or paid by the
7	Department to represent him or her the inmate at the administrative
8	hearing; and
9	2. Once an inmate has been assigned to a unit described in this
10	subsection, treatment and medication may be administered to the
11	inmate as provided in Section 5-204 of Title 43A of the Oklahoma
12	Statutes.
13	B. The Carl Albert Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services
14	Center shall provide to the Department of Corrections a psychiatrist
15	as needed to assist in a unit described in subsection A of this
16	section.
17	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2021.
