16	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
17	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 22 O.S. 2011, Section 189, is
18	amended to read as follows:
19	Section 189. <u>A.</u> If the offense charged is a felony, the arrest
20	may be made on any day, and at any time of the day or night.
21	<u>B.</u> If it is <u>the offense charged is</u> a misdemeanor, the arrest
22	may be made only during the hours of $\frac{1}{2}$ six o'clock $\frac{6:00}{2}$ a.m. to $\frac{1}{2}$ to
23	o'clock 10:00 p.m., inclusive, except as otherwise may be directed
24	by the magistrate endorsed upon the warrant. Provided, an arrest on

1	a warrant which charges a misdemeanor offense may be made at any
2	time of the day or night if the defendant is in a public place $rac{\partial r_{\prime}}{\partial r}$
3	on a public roadway, or at any other place and is contacted by a law
4	enforcement officer during the performance of his or her duties;
5	provided that, the serving of the warrant is not the primary reason
6	for said contact with the defendant.
7	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2021.
