7 AS INTRODUCED

8 An Act relating to schools; authorizing the Council
9 on Law Enforcement Education and Training to offer
10 certain training; limiting information that may be
 released; defining term; providing for codification;
 and providing an effective date.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3311.19 of Title 70, unless
16 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 A. The Council on Law Enforcement Education and Training may
18 offer training that instructs a peace officer how to alert a school
19 district or charter school when a student enrolled at the school
20 district or charter school has been identified at the scene of a
21 traumatic event or an event that involved a response from an
22 emergency 9-1-1 service. The peace officer may only release the
23 name and birth date of the student directly to the school district
24 or charter school and state that the student was present at the

1 scene of a traumatic event or an event that involved a response from
2 an emergency 9-1-1 service.

3 B. As used in subsection A of this section, "student" means a
4 minor child or a person who has reached eighteen (18) years of age
5 and continues to be enrolled in school.

6 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2021.
