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17	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
18	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 10 O.S. 2011, Section 405.3, as
19	last amended by Section 2, Chapter 253, O.S.L. 2017 (10 O.S. Supp.
20	2020, Section 405.3), is amended to read as follows:
21	Section 405.3 A. The Department of Human Services shall
22	promulgate rules to establish and maintain the Restricted Registry,
23	accessible to the public through an online database, to address:
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1 A procedure for recording individuals on the Restricted
 2 Registry resulting from:

3	a.	a substantiated finding of abuse or neglect, as
4		defined in Section 1-1-105 of Title 10A of the
5		Oklahoma Statutes, by an individual when the abuse or
6		neglect occurred to a child while in the care of a
7		facility licensed, certified, operated or contracted
8		by or with the Department or the Office of Juvenile
9		Affairs. The provisions of this subparagraph shall
10		apply to:
11		(1) the Central Oklahoma Juvenile Center, the
12		Oklahoma Juvenile Center for Girls and the
13		Southwest Oklahoma Juvenile Center upon the
14		effective date of this act, and
15		(2) facilities licensed by, certified by or
16		contracting with the Office of Juvenile Affairs
17		after November 1, 2018,
18	b.	a revocation or denial of a child care facility
19		license, and
20	с.	a specified criminal history of an individual, as
21		defined by rules promulgated by the Department;
22	2. A pro	cedure to provide notice and an opportunity for review

3 3. Disclosure requirements for information on the Restricted4 Registry; and

4. A procedure to prohibit licensure, ownership, employment,
unsupervised access to children or residence in a facility or
program licensed, certified, operated or contracted with by the
Department or the Office of Juvenile Affairs.

9 B. The Restricted Registry shall include, but not be limited10 to:

11 1. The full name of the individual;

Information necessary to identify the individual; and
 The date the individual was recorded on the Restricted
 Registry.

15 C. Nothing in this section shall be construed as to permit the 16 placement of an operator of a child care facility on the Restricted 17 Registry unless the operator:

18 1. Is the subject of a substantiated finding of child abuse or 19 neglect;

20 2. Has been subject to a revocation or denial of a child care 21 facility license; or

3. Has a specified criminal history, as defined by rules
promulgated by the Department.
