13	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
14	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 6-215 of Title 2, unless there
16	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
17	Persons shall not label any bovine product as Oklahoma Certified
18	Beef unless it meets the definition of Oklahoma certified beef as
19	defined in Section 6-214 of Title 2 of the Oklahoma Statutes. The
20	Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry shall enforce
21	this requirement pursuant to Section 2-18 of Title 2 of the Oklahoma
22	Statutes.
23	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2021.

1	SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
2	of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
3	declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
4	be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
