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10 PROPOSED COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

11 An Act relating to elections; prohibiting disclosure
12 of names of certain voters; amending 26 O.S. 2011,
13 Section 14-130, which relates to posting of voter
14 lists; providing exception; providing for
15 codification; and providing an effective date.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
18 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 7-109.1 of Title 26, unless
19 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

20 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the names of
21 individual voters shall not be available for public inspection or
22 disclosed by the Oklahoma State Election Board or any county
23 election board in a form disaggregated into subgroups of absentee

1 voting, early voting or in-person voting if the disaggregation
2 results in a subgroup of less than one hundred (100) voters.

3 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 26 O.S. 2011, Section 14-130, is
4 amended to read as follows:

5 Section 14-130. ~~The~~ A. Except as provided by subsection B of
6 this section, the secretary of each county election board shall
7 publicly post a list of all voters by precinct who have requested
8 absentee ballots at the office of the county election board on the
9 day preceding the election.

10 B. The list of voters requesting absentee ballots in a
11 precinct shall not be publicly posted if the number of voters in
12 such subgroup is less than one hundred (100).

13 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2021.
