7 AS INTRODUCED

8 An Act relating to public health; requiring newborn
9 screening specimens to be evaluated and reported
10 within forty-eight hours of collection; providing for
 codification; and providing an effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-534.01 of Title 63, unless
15 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 Any specimen collected pursuant to the newborn screening program
17 set forth in Sections 1-533 and 1-534 of Title 63 of the Oklahoma
18 Statutes shall be evaluated by a laboratory and the results reported
19 to the screening hospital or physician within forty-eight (48) hours
20 of the collection of such specimen.

21 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
