7                               COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

8                   An Act relating to higher education; directing the  
9                   Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education and the  
10                  Oklahoma Department of Career and Technology  
11                  Education to prepare and publish an annual report;  
12                  requiring certain content; directing for presentation  
13                  of the report; directing that the report be publicly  
14                  available; permitting the Oklahoma State Regents for  
15                  Higher Education and the Oklahoma Department of  
16                  Career and Technology Education to promulgate rules;  
17                  providing for codification; and providing an  
18                  effective date.

19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

20           SECTION 1.       NEW LAW       A new section of law to be codified  
21           in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3217.1 of Title 70, unless there  
22           is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

23           A.   The Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education and the  
24           Oklahoma Department of Career and Technology Education shall prepare  
25           and publish annually a health care workforce report that shall  
26           include:

27           1.   Type of degrees offered in health care;

2. Student enrollment in health care degrees;
3. Percentage change in student enrollment for each degree;
4. Number of graduates for each degree;
5. Number of students retained in state after graduation;
6. Number of unfilled slots for each degree;
7. Number of faculty teaching the courses identified by position in health care taught, both full time and part time; and
8. Identify the number of positions in health care that each institution could teach each year if more resources were provided.

B. The report shall include actions taken by each state educational institution to address the health care workforce shortage in Oklahoma.

C. The Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education and the Oklahoma Department of Career and Technology Education shall report the information in this act to the Governor, President Pro Tempore of the Oklahoma State Senate, and Speaker of the Oklahoma House of Representatives no later than January of each year. The report shall also be made publicly available by January of each year.

D. The Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education and the Oklahoma Department of Career and Technology Education shall promulgate rules to carry out the provisions of this act.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
