## AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act; amending 47 O.S. 2021, Section 1104.1, which relates to the Adaptive Grant Program for Oklahomans with Intellectual Disabilities; directing the Department of Human Services to contract with certain organizations for certain purposes; providing exemption from the Central Purchasing Act; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2021, Section 1104.1  
amended to read as follows:

Section 1104.1 A. Twenty-three Dollars (\$23.00) of the amount authorized by Section 1135.5 of this title for university or college supporter license plates which are received each year by the Oklahoma Tax Commission or its motor license agents shall be apportioned as follows:

1. Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) of the fee for each license plate designating a particular state university or college shall be

1 apporportioned to the particular state university or college so  
2 designated on the license plate. Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) of the fee  
3 for each license plate designating a particular private university  
4 or college shall be apporportioned to the particular private university  
5 or college so designated on the license plate and may be used by the  
6 private university or college as compensation for use of the  
7 symbols, words, or letters authorized by the private university or  
8 college for use on the license plate; and

9 2. Three Dollars (\$3.00) shall be deposited to the Adaptive  
10 Grant Program for Oklahomans with Intellectual Disabilities  
11 Revolving Fund created by this section to be used for educational  
12 purposes.

13 B. There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving  
14 fund for the Department of Human Services to be designated the  
15 "Adaptive Grant Program for Oklahomans with Intellectual  
16 Disabilities Revolving Fund". The fund shall be a continuing fund,  
17 not subject to fiscal year limitations, and shall consist of all  
18 funds deposited therein pursuant to the provisions of paragraph 2 of  
19 subsection A of this section. All monies accruing to the credit of  
20 the fund are hereby appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by  
21 the Department of Human Services for the administration of the  
22 Adaptive Grant Program for Oklahomans with Intellectual  
23 Disabilities.

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1 C. The Director of the Department of Human Services is hereby  
2 directed to promulgate rules to create the Adaptive Grant Program  
3 for Oklahomans with Intellectual Disabilities Program to provide  
4 financial assistance in adaptation of furnishings, fixtures,  
5 vehicles, equipment or structures in order to meet any special needs  
6 of Oklahomans with intellectual disabilities; provided, recipients  
7 of grants awarded pursuant to the program shall be limited to those  
8 programs, projects or persons not otherwise qualifying for state or  
9 federal funding. The Department of Human Services is authorized to  
10 contract with a statewide private, nonprofit foundation certified to  
11 be a 501(c)(3) organization by the Internal Revenue Service for  
12 administration of the program. The Department of Human Services is  
13 hereby directed to contract with the Oklahoma City Community  
14 Foundation or other statewide, private 501(c)(3) nonprofit  
15 organizations for the administration of this program. Any contract  
16 entered into pursuant to this section shall be exempt from the  
17 Central Purchasing Act.

18 D. The Director of Human Services shall prepare an annual  
19 report on the program. Such report shall be submitted to the  
20 Governor, the President Pro Tempore of the Senate and the Speaker of  
21 the House of Representatives.

22 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
