9 AS INTRODUCED

10 An Act relating to schools; authorizing school
11 district to offer law enforcement elective course to
12 juniors and seniors; listing certain information to
13 be included in course; permitting State Board of
14 Education to coordinate with the Council on Law
15 Enforcement Education and Training; authorizing Board
16 to promulgate rules; providing for codification; and
17 providing an effective date.

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

19 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
20 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 11-103.15 of Title 70, unless
21 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

22 A. A school district may offer to students in grades eleven and
23 twelve an elective course in law enforcement.

24 B. The law enforcement elective course shall include, at a
minimum:

1 1. A general introduction to law enforcement training;

2 2. Critical skills and entry requirements for law enforcement
3 professionals; and

4 3. Career opportunities in law enforcement.

5 C. The State Board of Education may coordinate with the Council
6 on Law Enforcement Education and Training to develop instructional
7 materials and curricula for schools to use in the law enforcement
8 elective course. The Board may promulgate rules to implement the
9 provisions of this section.

10 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
