17	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
18	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
19	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 11-103.15 of Title 70, unless
20	there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
21	A. A school district may offer to students in grades eleven and
22	twelve an elective course in law enforcement.
23	B. The law enforcement elective course shall include, at a
24	minimum:

1	1. A general introduction to law enforcement training;
2	2. Critical skills and entry requirements for law enforcement
3	professionals; and
4	3. Career opportunities in law enforcement.
5	C. The State Board of Education may coordinate with the Council
6	on Law Enforcement Education and Training to develop instructional
7	materials and curricula for schools to use in the law enforcement
8	elective course. The Board may promulgate rules to implement the
9	provisions of this section.
10	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
