15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
16	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
17	codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:
18	There is hereby appropriated to the Department of Commerce from
19	any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund
20	of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2023, the
21	sum of Three Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$350,000.00) to be
22	utilized by the Department in partnership with a Federal
23	Communications Commission (FCC) licensee associated with an
24	institution of the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education, for

1	the purpose of establishing distance learning classrooms to deliver
2	multipronged educational resources, utilizing over-the-air
3	television broadcasts, online streaming and website accessible
4	archives delivering college credit classes, career training, and at
5	home learning resources, with the intent of growing a statewide
6	network of public school delivery sites serving high school juniors
7	and seniors.
8	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2022.
9	SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
10	of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
11	declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
12	be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
