10	An Act relating to fees; amending 28 O.S. 2021, Section 152, which relates to court fee schedule;
11	changing funding process for courtroom interpreter services; amending 28 O.S. 2021, Section 153, which
12	relates to costs in criminal cases; eliminating cost for services of a language interpreter; removing
13	references to services of a language interpreter; removing restriction on dismissing or waiving costs;
14	providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.
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17	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
18	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 28 O.S. 2021, Section 152, is
19	amended to read as follows:
20	Section 152. A. In any civil case filed in a district court,
21	the court clerk shall collect, at the time of filing, the following
22	flat fees, none of which shall ever be refundable, and which shall
23	be the only charge for court costs, except as is otherwise
24	specifically provided for by law:

1	1. Actions for divorce, alimony without divorce, separate
2	maintenance, custody or support\$183.00
3	2. Any ancillary proceeding to modify or vacate a divorce
4	decree providing for custody or support\$43.00
5	3. Probate and guardianship\$135.00
6	4. Annual guardianship report
7	5. Any proceeding for sale or lease of real or personal
8	property or mineral interest in probate or guardianship\$43.00
9	6. Any proceeding to revoke the probate of a will\$43.00
10	7. Judicial determination of death
11	8. Adoption\$105.00
12	9. Civil actions for an amount of Ten Thousand Dollars
13	(\$10,000.00) or less and condemnation\$150.00
14	10. Civil actions for an amount of Ten Thousand One
15	Dollars (\$10,001.00) or more\$163.00
16	11. Garnishment\$23.00
17	12. Continuing wage garnishment
18	13. Any other proceeding after judgment\$33.00
19	14. All others, including but not limited to actions for
20	forcible entry and detainer, judgments from all other courts,
21	including the Workers' Compensation Court
22	15. Notice of renewal of judgment
23	B. In addition to the amounts collected pursuant to paragraphs
24	1, 3, 7, 8, 9, 10 and 14 of subsection A of this section, the sum of

Six Dollars (\$6.00) shall be assessed and credited to the Law
 Library Fund.

C. In addition to the amounts collected pursuant to subsections
A and B of this section, the sum of Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00)
shall be assessed and credited to the Oklahoma Court Information
System Revolving Fund created pursuant to Section 1315 of Title 20
of the Oklahoma Statutes.

D. In addition to the amounts collected pursuant to subsection
A of this section, the sum of Five Dollars (\$5.00) shall be assessed
and credited to the Oklahoma court-appointed special advocates
(OCASA).

E. In addition to the amounts collected pursuant to subsection A of this section, the sum of Two Dollars (\$2.00) shall be assessed and credited as follows:

15 1. One Dollar and fifty-five cents (\$1.55) of such amount shall 16 be credited to the Council on Judicial Complaints Revolving Fund; 17 and

18 2. Forty-five cents (\$0.45) of such amount shall be credited to 19 the Supreme Court Revolving Fund and to be used to reimburse 20 district courts for expenses related to services of interpreters and 21 translators. Vouchers for such expenses shall be submitted by the 22 district court and may be budgeted and expended by the Supreme Court 23 for expenses lawfully incurred for providing qualified courtroom 24 interpreter services in the district courts, for credentialing and training Oklahoma courtroom interpreters, and for any other
expenditures determined by the Supreme Court to be necessary to
provide language access in the district courts as required by state
and federal law. Payments of expenses may be made after the claim
or expense is approved by the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court or
another justice designated by the Chief Justice.

F. In addition to the amounts collected pursuant to paragraphs 1, 3, 8, 9, 10 and 14 of subsection A of this section, each county may assess, upon approval by the board of county commissioners, a sum not to exceed Ten Dollars (\$10.00) per case to be credited to the Sheriff's Service Fee Account in the county in which the action arose for the purpose of enhancing existing or providing additional courthouse security.

G. Until November 1, 2027, in addition to the amounts collected pursuant to subsection A of this section, the sum of Ten Dollars (\$10.00) shall be assessed and credited to the Court Clerk's Records Management and Preservation Fund created in Section 31.3 of this title.

H. In any case in which a litigant claims to have a just cause of action and that, by reason of poverty, the litigant is unable to pay the fees and costs provided for in this section and is financially unable to employ counsel, upon the filing of an affidavit in forma pauperis executed before any officer authorized by law to administer oaths to that effect and upon satisfactory

1 showing to the court that the litigant has no means and is, 2 therefore, unable to pay the applicable fees and costs and to employ 3 counsel, no fees or costs shall be required. The opposing party or 4 parties may file with the court clerk of the court having 5 jurisdiction of the cause an affidavit similarly executed 6 contradicting the allegation of poverty. In all such cases, the 7 court shall promptly set for hearing the determination of eligibility to litigate without payment of fees or costs. Until a 8 9 final order is entered determining that the affiant is ineligible, 10 the clerk shall permit the affiant to litigate without payment of 11 fees or costs. Any litigant executing a false affidavit or counter 12 affidavit pursuant to the provisions of this section shall be guilty 13 of perjury.

I. Payments to the court clerk for fees and costs assessed
pursuant to this section may be made by a nationally recognized
credit or debit card or other electronic payment method as provided
in paragraph 1 of subsection B of Section 151 of this title.

The clerks of the courts shall collect as 21 costs in every criminal case for each offense of which the defendant 22 is convicted, irrespective of whether or not the sentence is 23 deferred, the following flat charges and no more, except for 24 standing and parking violations and for charges otherwise provided

7	10. For the services of a language interpreter, other than an
8	interpreter appointed pursuant to the provisions of the Oklahoma

11	B. In addition to the amount collected pursuant to paragraphs 2
12	through 6 of subsection A of this section, the sum of Six Dollars
13	(\$6.00) shall be assessed and credited to the Law Library Fund
14	pursuant to Section 1201 et seq. of Title 20 of the Oklahoma
15	Statutes.
16	C. In addition to the amount collected pursuant to subsection A
17	of this section, the sum of Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) shall be
18	assessed and collected in every traffic case for each offense other
19	than for driving under the influence of alcohol or other
20	intoxicating substance; the sum of Thirty Dollars (\$30.00) shall be
21	assessed and collected in every misdemeanor case for each offense;
22	the sum of Thirty Dollars (\$30.00) shall be assessed and collected
23	in every misdemeanor case for each offense for driving under the
24	influence of alcohol or other intoxicating substance; the sum of

Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) shall be assessed and collected in every felony case for each offense; and the sum of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) shall be assessed and collected in every felony case for each offense for driving under the influence of alcohol or other intoxicating substance.

D. In addition to the amounts collected pursuant to subsections
A and B of this section, the sum of Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00)
shall be assessed and credited to the Oklahoma Court Information
System Revolving Fund created pursuant to Section 1315 of Title 20
of the Oklahoma Statutes.

E. In addition to the amount collected pursuant to paragraphs 1 through 6 of subsection A of this section, the sum of Ten Dollars (\$10.00) shall be assessed and credited to the Sheriff's Service Fee Account in the county in which the conviction occurred for the purpose of enhancing existing or providing additional courthouse security.

F. In addition to the amounts collected pursuant to paragraphs
18 1 through 6 of subsection A of this section, the sum of Three
Dollars (\$3.00) shall be assessed and credited to the Office of the
Attorney General Victim Services Unit.

G. In addition to the amounts collected pursuant to paragraphs
1 through 6 of subsection A of this section, the sum of Three
Dollars (\$3.00) shall be assessed and credited to the Child Abuse

Multidisciplinary Account. This fee shall not be used for purposes
 of hiring or employing any law enforcement officers.

H. In addition to the amount collected pursuant to paragraphs 5
and 6 of subsection A of this section, the sum of Fifteen Dollars
(\$15.00) shall be assessed in every misdemeanor or felony case for
each offense of driving under the influence of alcohol or other
intoxicating substance and credited to the Oklahoma Impaired Driver
Database Revolving Fund created pursuant to Section 8 of Enrolled
House Bill No. 3146 of the 2nd Session of the 55th Oklahoma

10 Legislature 11-902d of Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

I. Prior to conviction, parties in criminal cases shall not be required to pay, advance, or post security for the services of a language interpreter or for the issuance or service of process to obtain compulsory attendance of witnesses.

J. The amounts to be assessed as court costs upon filing of a case shall be those amounts above-stated in paragraph 3 or 4 of subsection A and subsections B, C, D and E of this section.

18 K. The fees collected pursuant to this section shall be19 deposited into the court fund, except the following:

A court clerk issuing a misdemeanor warrant is entitled to
 ten percent (10%) of the sheriff's service fee, provided for in
 paragraph 9 of subsection A of this section, collected on a warrant
 referred to the contractor for the misdemeanor warrant notification
 program governed by Sections 514.4 and 514.5 of Title 19 of the

1 Oklahoma Statutes. This ten-percent sum shall be deposited into the issuing Court Clerk's Revolving Fund, created pursuant to Section 2 220 of Title 19 of the Oklahoma Statutes, of the court clerk issuing 3 the warrant with the balance of the sheriff's service fee to be 4 5 deposited into the Sheriff's Service Fee Account, created pursuant to the provisions of Section 514.1 of Title 19 of the Oklahoma 6 7 Statutes, of the sheriff in the county in which service is made or attempted. Otherwise, the sheriff's service fee, when collected, 8 9 shall be deposited in its entirety into the Sheriff's Service Fee 10 Account of the sheriff in the county in which service is made or 11 attempted;

12 2. The sheriff's fee provided for in Section 153.2 of this 13 title;

3. The witness fees paid by the district attorney pursuant to the provisions of Section 82 of this title which, if collected by the court clerk, shall be transferred to the district attorney's office in the county where witness attendance was required. Fees transferred pursuant to this paragraph shall be deposited in the district attorney's maintenance and operating expense account;

4. The fees provided for in subsection C of this section shall
be forwarded to the District Attorneys Council Revolving Fund to
defray the costs of prosecution; and

23 5. The following amounts of the fees provided for in paragraphs
24 2, 3, 5 and 6 of subsection A of this section, when collected, shall

be deposited in the Trauma Care Assistance Revolving Fund, created pursuant to the provisions of Section 1-2530.9 of Title 63 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

- 4 a. Ten Dollars (\$10.00) of the Ninety-eight-Dollar fee
  5 provided for in paragraph 2 of subsection A of this
  6 section,
- b. Ten Dollars (\$10.00) of the Ninety-three-Dollar fee
  provided for in paragraph 3 of subsection A of this
  section,
- 10 c. One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) of the Four-Hundred 11 Thirty-three-Dollar fee provided for in paragraph 5 of
   12 subsection A of this section, and
- 13 d. One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) of the Four-Hundred 14 Thirty-three-Dollar fee provided for in paragraph 6 of
   15 subsection A of this section.

16 L. Costs required to be collected pursuant to this section 17 shall not be dismissed or waived; provided, if the court determines 18 that a person needing the services of a language interpreter is 19 indigent, the court may waive all or part of the costs or require

20 the payment of costs in installments.

21 M. As used in this section, "convicted" means any final 22 adjudication of guilt, whether pursuant to a plea of guilty or nolo 23 contendere or otherwise, and any deferred judgment or suspended 24 sentence.

1 N. A court clerk may accept in payment for any fee, fine, 2 forfeiture payment, cost, penalty assessment or other charge or collection to be assessed or collected by a court clerk pursuant to 3 4 this section a nationally recognized credit card or debit card or 5 other electronic payment method as provided in paragraph 1 of 6 subsection B of Section 151 of this title. 7 Upon receipt of payment of fines and costs for offenses <del>O.</del> N. 8 charged prior to July 1, 1992, the court clerk shall apportion and 9 pay Thirteen Dollars (\$13.00) per conviction to the court fund. 10 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 2022. 11 SECTION 4.
