11 An Act relating to memorial highways and bridges;
12 designating the Senator Roger Ballenger Memorial
13 Highway; designating the Judge Dean Linder Memorial
14 Highway; designating the Loyd Stout Highway;
15 designating the SGT Ronald Crews Bridge; designating
16 the Vernus W. Bales Memorial Highway; designating the
17 MAJ Kerry "WarDog 6" Trent and SSG Michael D. Ward
18 Memorial Trail; designating the SGT Billy Rodgers
19 Memorial Bridge; designating the Harold Haltom
20 Memorial Highway; amending 69 O.S. 2021, Section
21 1698.310, which relates to the Private Robert "Bob"
22 Clark Memorial Bridge; modifying location
23 description; amending 69 O.S. 2021, Section 1698.334,
24 which relates to the CSM Junior H. Honeycutt Memorial
 Highway; modifying location description; amending 69
 O.S. 2021, Section 1698.351, which relates to the
 Martin Dyer Memorial Highway; modifying name of the
 highway; amending 69 O.S. 2021, Section 1698.354,
 which relates to the Lonnie D. Cook Memorial Highway;
 modifying name of the highway; providing for
 codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

1 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
2 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.364 of Title 69, unless
3 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

4 The section of State Highway 56 beginning at the intersection of
5 Dripping Springs Road extending easterly to the intersection of
6 Madison Avenue on the west side of the city of Okmulgee in Okmulgee
7 County shall be designated as the "Senator Roger Ballenger Memorial
8 Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable
9 permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the highway.

10 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
11 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.365 of Title 69, unless
12 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

13 The section of U.S. Highway 281 beginning at the intersection of
14 N2400 Road extending approximately five (5) miles east then north to
15 the intersection of E270 Road, south of Alva in Woods County shall
16 be designated as the "Judge Dean Linder Memorial Highway". The
17 Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers
18 bearing that name to be placed on the highway.

19 SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
20 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.366 of Title 69, unless
21 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

22 The section of U.S. Highway 64 beginning at the northern
23 municipal limits of Cherokee extending north to the intersection of
24 State Highway 11 in Alfalfa County shall be designated as the "Loyd

1 Stout Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause
2 suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the
3 highway.

4 SECTION 4. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
5 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.367 of Title 69, unless
6 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

7 The bridge crossing over the Turner Turnpike located on State
8 Highway 18 at the north edge of Chandler in Lincoln County shall be
9 designated as the "SGT Ronald Crews Bridge". The Department of
10 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that
11 name to be placed on the bridge.

12 SECTION 5. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.368 of Title 69, unless
14 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

15 The section of U.S. Highway 59 in Stilwell beginning on the
16 north side of the State Highway 100 intersection extending north to
17 the intersection of State Highway 51 East in Adair County shall be
18 designated as the "Vernus W. Bales Memorial Highway". The
19 Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers
20 bearing that name to be placed on the highway.

21 SECTION 6. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
22 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.369 of Title 69, unless
23 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

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1 The sections of U.S. Highways 60 Business and 60 extending
2 between the Tonkawa and Ponca City National Guard armories in Kay
3 County shall be designated as the "MAJ Kerry "WarDog 6" Trent and
4 SSG Michael D. Ward Memorial Trail". The Department of
5 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that
6 name to be placed on the highways.

7 SECTION 7. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
8 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.370 of Title 69, unless
9 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

10 The bridge crossing over Coal Creek on U.S. Highway 59 north of
11 Panama in LeFlore County shall be designated as the "SGT Billy
12 Rodgers Memorial Bridge". The Department of Transportation shall
13 cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on
14 the bridge.

15 SECTION 8. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
16 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.371 of Title 69, unless
17 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

18 The section of State Highway 71 beginning at the intersection of
19 State Highway 9 in Haskell County extending north six (6) miles to
20 the intersection of S4306 Road in McIntosh County shall be
21 designated as the "Harold Haltom Memorial Highway". The Department
22 of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing
23 that name to be placed on the highway.

1 SECTION 9. AMENDATORY 69 O.S. 2021, Section 1698.310, is
2 amended to read as follows:

3 Section 1698.310 The bridge over the Cimarron River on U.S.
4 Highway ~~15~~ 287 approximately thirteen (13) miles north of Boise City
5 shall be designated as the "Private Robert "Bob" Clark Memorial
6 Bridge". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable
7 permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the bridge.

8 SECTION 10. AMENDATORY 69 O.S. 2021, Section 1698.334,
9 is amended to read as follows:

10 Section 1698.334 Notwithstanding any other provision of law,
11 the section of State Highway 28A in Rogers County beginning at the
12 intersection of State Highway 66 near the Town of Foyil, extending
13 east to the intersection of State Highway 28, then continuing east
14 to the Interstate 44 in Rogers County interchange in Mayes County
15 shall be designated as the "CSM Junior H. Honeycutt Memorial
16 Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable
17 permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the highway.

18 SECTION 11. AMENDATORY 69 O.S. 2021, Section 1698.351,
19 is amended to read as follows:

20 Section 1698.351 Notwithstanding any other provision of law,
21 the section of U.S. Highway 77 beginning at the intersection of
22 Broadway Avenue in Ardmore extending north to the intersection of
23 State Highway 142 in Carter County shall be designated as the "Mayor
24 Martin Dyer Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation

1 shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to ~~the~~ be
2 placed on the highway.

3 SECTION 12. AMENDATORY 69 O.S. 2021, Section 1698.354,
4 is amended to read as follows:

5 Section 1698.354 The section of U.S. Highway 62 beginning at
6 the intersection of N3990 Road extending east through the town of
7 Morris to the intersection of N 4030 Road in Okmulgee County shall
8 be designated as the "USS Arizona Survivor Lonnie D. Cook Memorial
9 Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable
10 permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the highway.

11 SECTION 13. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
