11 An Act relating to emergency services; creating the
12 Oklahoma Task Force 1 Urban Search and Rescue Out of
13 State Deployments Revolving Fund; providing for
14 codification; and providing an effective date.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
17 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 330.98 of Title 63, unless there
18 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

19 There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving fund
20 for the Oklahoma Office of Homeland Security, to be designated the
21 "Oklahoma Task Force 1 Urban Search and Rescue Out of State
22 Deployments Revolving Fund". The fund shall be a continuing fund,
23 not subject to fiscal year limitations, and shall consist of all
24 monies deposited to the credit of the fund by law. All monies

1 accruing to the credit of the fund are hereby appropriated and may
2 be budgeted and expended by the Oklahoma Office of Homeland Security
3 for the direct reimbursement of participating agencies with Oklahoma
4 Task Force 1 Urban Search and Rescue (OKTF1 USAR) as is consistent
5 with the federal Emergency Management Assistance Compact Guidelines.
6 Expenditures from the fund shall be made upon warrants issued by the
7 State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by law with the
8 Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services for
9 approval and payment.

10 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
