12 An Act relating to the State Department of Health;
13 requiring the utilization of certain funds for
14 certain purposes; providing for noncodification;
15 repealing Section 5, Chapter 533, O.S.L. 2021, which
16 relates to position staffing for the Oklahoma Medical
17 Marijuana Authority; and declaring an emergency.

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

19 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
20 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

21 From the funds available for budgeting and expenditure during
22 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2022, the State Department of Health
23 shall utilize an amount necessary to successfully regulate and
24 enforce all programs and provisions associated with the Oklahoma
25 Medical Marijuana Authority. Such efforts shall include but not be

1 limited to the hiring and employment of additional staff at the
2 Oklahoma Medical Marijuana Authority, as well as, participating in
3 interagency agreements with state law enforcement agencies for
4 enhanced enforcement.

5 SECTION 2. REPEALER Section 5, Chapter 533, O.S.L. 2021,
6 is hereby repealed.

7 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
8 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
9 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
10 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
