12	An Act relating to the Department of Public Safety;
13	amending 47 O.S. 2021, Section 2-146, which relates to the Department of Public Safety Patrol Academy
14	Revolving Fund; requiring reporting of Oklahoma Highway Patrol Trooper Academies to the Oklahoma
15	Legislature; requiring reporting of expenditures from the Department of Public Safety Patrol Academy
16	Revolving Fund; requiring reporting of monies accruing to the credit of the Department of Public
17	Safety Patrol Academy Revolving Fund; requiring reporting of certain information relating to Oklahoma
18	Highway Patrol Trooper Academies; and providing an effective date.
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20	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
21	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2021, Section 2-146, is
22	amended to read as follows:
23	Section 2-146. A. There is hereby created in the State
24	Treasury a revolving fund for the Department of Public Safety, to be

1 designated the "Department of Public Safety Patrol Academy Revolving 2 The fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations. All monies accruing to the credit of said fund 3 4 are hereby appropriated and shall be budgeted and expended by the 5 Department of Public Safety for the exclusive purpose of Oklahoma 6 Highway Patrol Trooper Academies. Expenditures from said fund shall 7 be made upon warrants issued by the State Treasurer against claims 8 filed as prescribed by law with the Director of the Office of 9 Management and Enterprise Services for approval and payment.

- 10 B. On or before December 1 of each year, the Department of 11 Public Safety shall provide a written report on all Oklahoma Highway 12 Patrol Trooper Academies conducted in the then current and preceding 13 state fiscal year to the Speaker of the Oklahoma House of 14 Representatives, the President Pro Tempore of the State Senate, the 15 Chair of the Appropriations and Budget Committee of the Oklahoma 16 House of Representatives, and the Chair of the Appropriations 17 Committee of the State Senate. Such report shall include, but not 18 be limited to, the following information for the then current and 19 preceding state fiscal year:
 - 1. A description of all expenditures from the Department of Public Safety Patrol Academy Revolving Fund;
- 22 <u>2. A description of the source of all monies accruing to the</u>
 23 <u>credit of the Department of Public Safety Patrol Academy Revolving</u>
 24 Fund;

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1	3. A description of all expenditures, including the source of
2	funds for said expenditures, used to conduct each academy;
3	4. The total number of applicants for each academy;
4	5. The total number of persons admitted for each academy;
5	6. The total number of persons graduating from each academy;
6	7. The total number of persons graduating from each academy
7	that do not accept a position within the Oklahoma Highway Patrol;
8	8. The total number of persons graduating from each academy
9	that, upon accepting a position within the Oklahoma Highway Patrol,
10	do not complete service of an initial probationary period as
11	determined by the Department of Public Safety;
12	9. The net number of troopers added to the Oklahoma Highway
13	Patrol in a calendar year;
14	10. A description of any academies planned to be conducted in
15	the upcoming state fiscal year; and
16	11. A description of any planned academy or academies to be
17	conducted within the remaining fiscal year that includes, but is not
18	limited to, the estimated cost of the academy and the proposed
19	source or sources of funding.
20	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
