7                               AS INTRODUCED

8               A Resolution designating November 2022 as Men's  
9               Health Awareness Month.

10  
11           WHEREAS, men are one hundred percent (100%) less likely than  
12 women to pursue annual screening and preventive care; and

13           WHEREAS, nearly sixty percent (60%) of men do not regularly see  
14 a doctor; and

15           WHEREAS, men die an average of five (5) years earlier than  
16 women; and

17           WHEREAS, only seven percent (7%) of men report discussing their  
18 health; and

19           WHEREAS, higher mortality rates for men result in negative  
20 economic, social, and emotional consequences for their surviving  
21 families; and

22           WHEREAS, lack of awareness of and adherence to medical  
23 recommendations and protocols contributes to men's poor health  
24 outcomes.

1       NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES  
2       OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 58TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

3       THAT November 2022, is hereby designated Men's Health Awareness  
4       Month.
