10 AS INTRODUCED

11 A Concurrent Resolution recognizing and celebrating
12 the Fiftieth Anniversary of the Oklahoma Museums
13 Association.

14 WHEREAS, the Oklahoma Museums Association was established on May
15 24, 1972, with a mission to promote the general welfare of museums
16 and their advancement as educational institutions, as agencies of
17 scientific research, and as cultural centers; to foster continued
18 improvement of the museum profession through the development of high
19 standards of ethics, conduct, education, and scholarly attainments;
20 to increase and diffuse knowledge through meetings, reports, papers,
21 discussions, publications, and media; and to encourage cooperation
22 among Oklahoma museums and those interested in them; and

23 WHEREAS, the Oklahoma Museums Association currently serves over
24 five hundred museums and cultural organizations which are located in

1 every region of the state and serve as educational institutions,
2 preservation organizations, agencies of scientific discovery, and
3 cultural centers; and

4 WHEREAS, the Oklahoma Museums Association represents a multitude
5 of disciplines and learning experiences, including art museums,
6 historical societies, historic sites, zoos, aquariums, science
7 centers, botanical gardens, historic houses, natural history
8 museums, children's museums, heritage centers, living history
9 museums, tribal cultural centers, and museums; and

10 WHEREAS, the Oklahoma Museums Association assists a variety of
11 institutions in responding to community need and audience
12 engagement, professional development for teachers, and education
13 resources for Oklahoma's students; and

14 WHEREAS, the Oklahoma Museums Association encourages curiosity,
15 enjoyment, and education for every generation and every community;
16 and

17 WHEREAS, the Oklahoma Museums Association has served to bring
18 important recognition of all museums, the growth of professional
19 standards, and training; and

20 WHEREAS, the Oklahoma Museums Association serves as a model for
21 state museum associations across the nation gaining recognition as a
22 leader in the field.
