1 HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES - FLOOR VERSION 2 STATE OF OKLAHOMA 2nd Session of the 58th Legislature (2022) 3 HOUSE CONCURRENT 4 RESOLUTION 1021 By: Sterling 5 6 7 8 AS INTRODUCED 9 A Concurrent Resolution requesting a performance audit of the Oklahoma Turnpike Authority; stating 10 impact of certain proposed projects on citizens of Oklahoma; recognizing certain authority; requesting the performance audit contain certain information; 11 requiring distribution of certain report; and 12 directing distribution. 1.3 14 WHEREAS, the Oklahoma Turnpike Authority was created and 15 authorized by the Oklahoma State Legislature in 1968 with the 16 purpose of constructing, maintaining, and operating turnpike 17 projects in this state; and 18 WHEREAS, the Oklahoma Turnpike Authority is authorized to issue 19 bonds to finance the construction, maintenance, and operations of 20 turnpike projects in this state; and 2.1 WHEREAS, the Oklahoma Turnpike Authority has proposed 22 constructing a series of additional turnpikes throughout this state 23 during the next fifteen (15) years and issuing bonds in the amount

of Five Billion Dollars (\$5,000,000,000.00); and

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WHEREAS, as a part of the fifteen-year plan, the Oklahoma

Turnpike Authority has proposed constructing a twenty-nine-mile

southern extension of the Kickapoo Turnpike running from Interstate

40 in Oklahoma City and connecting to Interstate 35 near the City of

Purcell which would run through the eastern part of the City of

Norman and surrounding communities; and

WHEREAS, as a part of the fifteen-year plan, the Oklahoma

Turnpike Authority has proposed constructing a twenty-eight-mile

outer loop east to west connector from the I-44 Tri-City area then

east to I-35 and then east to I-40 which would run through the City

of Moore and the City of Norman; and

WHEREAS, the proposed southern extension and east to west connector threaten the property and livelihoods of residents along the proposed route and may cause irreparable harm to the water table vital to the City of Norman, City of Midwest City, and the City of Del City, and surrounding communities; and

WHEREAS, the Oklahoma State Legislature is authorized to request performance audits of governmental entities as provided for in Section 213.2 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES

OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 58TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE SENATE

CONCURRING THEREIN:

THAT the Oklahoma State Legislature hereby requests the Office of the State Auditor and Inspector to conduct a performance audit of the Oklahoma Turnpike Authority every two (2) years.

THAT the audit shall answer the following questions:

- 1. A determination of the amount of revenue that is required to be generated in order for the Oklahoma Turnpike Authority to repay the original cost of existing turnpikes and the length of time it will take to generate the funds so that turnpikes can be conveyed to state ownership and converted to toll-free roads; and
- 2. Assess risk within the agency and develop performance audit objectives every two years.

THAT the State Auditor and Inspector, as part of the performance audit of the Oklahoma Turnpike Authority, shall identify the value and purchase price of all private property acquired by the Oklahoma Turnpike Authority for the southern extension of the Kickapoo Turnpike and ACCESS Oklahoma projects in Cleveland County, then shall:

- 1. Determine if source of funds used to purchase the properties was allowable in accordance with state law and if the deeds associated with those properties have been filed with the County Register of Deeds where the property is located; and
- 2. Determine if the purchase price of each property was evaluated and negotiated in accordance with state law. In addition, determine whether property owners were permitted to occupy the real

1	property acquired on a rental basis subsequent to the purchases, and
2	verify that rent did not exceed the fair rental values of the
3	property in accordance with state law.
4	THAT the Office of the State Auditor and Inspector shall provide
5	a written report of the performance audit to the Governor, President
6	Pro Tempore of the Senate, Speaker of the House of Representatives,
7	Legislative Office of Fiscal Transparency, and members of the
8	Transportation Committees of the Senate and House of
9	Representatives.
10	THAT copies of this resolution be distributed to the State
11	Auditor and Inspector and the Oklahoma Turnpike Authority.
