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8                               AS INTRODUCED

9           A Joint Resolution related to the provisions of  
10          Enrolled House Joint Resolution No. 1043 of the 2nd  
11          Session of the 56th Oklahoma Legislature; modifying  
12          provisions; repealing termination date; and directing  
13          filing.

14          WHEREAS, one of the provisions of Enrolled House Joint  
15          Resolution No. 1043 of the 2nd Session of the 56th Oklahoma  
16          Legislature contained a termination date; and

17          WHEREAS, the Legislature has reconsidered the circumstances  
18          involving the matters which were memorialized in the content of the  
19          Joint Resolution; and

20          WHEREAS, the Legislature through this Joint Resolution expresses  
21          its intent to remove the reference to the termination of the  
22          provisions of Enrolled House Joint Resolution No. 1043 of the 2nd  
23          Session of the 56th Oklahoma Legislature.

1       NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES  
2 OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 58TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE SENATE  
3 CONCURRING THEREIN:

4       THAT the clause which would have caused the provisions of  
5 Enrolled House Joint Resolution No. 1043 of the 2nd Session of the  
6 56th Oklahoma Legislature to terminate December 31, 2023, is  
7 repealed and nullified.

8       THAT the Chief Clerk of the House of Representatives,  
9 immediately after the passage of this resolution, shall prepare and  
10 file one copy thereof with the Secretary of State and one copy with  
11 the Attorney General and transmit copies to the President and  
12 Secretary of the United States Senate and to the Speaker and Clerk  
13 of the United States House of Representatives, to the members of the  
14 Oklahoma Congressional Delegation, and to the presiding officers of  
15 each of the legislative houses in the several states, requesting  
16 their cooperation.
