9	AS INTRODUCED
10	A Resolution asserting sovereignty under the Tenth
11	Amendment to the United States Constitution; serving notice to federal government of certain intent; and
12	directing distribution.
13	
14	WHEREAS, the Tenth Amendment to the Constitution of the United
15	States specifically provides that, "The powers not delegated to the
16	United States by the Constitution, nor prohibited by it to the
17	States, are reserved to the States respectively, or to the people";
18	and
19	WHEREAS, the Tenth Amendment limits the scope of federal power;
20	and
21	WHEREAS, the Second Amendment to the Constitution of the United
22	States provides, "the Right of the People to keep and bear arms,
23	shall not be infringed"; and
24	

WHEREAS, the Second Amendment is a limitation placed on the Federal Government; and

WHEREAS, the Constitution of the State of Oklahoma provides:
"The right of a citizen to keep and bear arms in defense of his home, person, or property, or in aid of the civil power, when thereunto legally summoned, shall never be prohibited"; and

WHEREAS, when taking the oath of office, all members of the Oklahoma House of Representatives solemnly swear that they will support, obey and defend the Constitution of the United States and the Constitution of the State of Oklahoma.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 1ST SESSION OF THE 58TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

THAT Oklahoma hereby asserts sovereignty under the Tenth

Amendment to the Constitution of the United States over all powers

not otherwise enumerated and delegated to the federal government by

the Constitution of the United States.

THAT this resolution shall serve notice to the federal government that H.R. 8, also known as the "Bipartisan Background Checks Act of 2021," First Session of the 117th Congress, introduced March 1, 2021, clearly violates the People's unalienable Rights, to include infringement on their Second Amendment Right "to keep and bear arms", their Fourth Amendment Right "to be secure in their persons ... and effects", as well as the People's Fifth Amendment Right to "due process of law".

2	Representatives, to exceed the enumerated authorities delegated to
3	the United States Congress.
