8                               AS INTRODUCED

9           A Resolution proclaiming April 19, 2022, as Wear Red  
10          Day for recognition of cardiovascular disease of  
11          women.

13          WHEREAS, cardiovascular diseases are the number one killer of  
14          women in the United States; and

15          WHEREAS, cardiovascular diseases kill one woman almost every 80  
16          seconds in the United States; and

17          WHEREAS, heart disease and stroke can affect all women at any  
18          age, heart attacks are on the rise in younger generations of women  
19          and Gen Z and Millennials are less likely to be aware of knowing the  
20          warning signs of heart attacks and strokes; and

21          WHEREAS, cardiovascular diseases kill one in three women, but  
22          about eighty percent (80%) of cardiac events can be prevented  
23          through education and lifestyle changes; and

1 WHEREAS, all women are encouraged to move more, eat smart, and  
2 manage blood pressure to reduce their risk of cardiovascular  
3 disease; and

4 WHEREAS, the American Heart Association's Go Red for Women  
5 movement motivates women to learn their family history and to meet  
6 with a health care provider to determine their risk for  
7 cardiovascular diseases and stroke; and

8 WHEREAS, as the trusted, passionate, and relevant force for  
9 change to eradicate heart disease and stroke in women, the American  
10 Heart Association's Go Red for Women remains steadfast and committed  
11 to meeting the comprehensive health needs of women - at every life  
12 stage; and

13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES  
14 OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 58TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

15 THAT the Oklahoma House of Representatives, in recognition of  
16 the importance of the ongoing fight against heart disease and  
17 stroke, do hereby proclaim Tuesday, April 19, 2022, to be WEAR RED  
18 DAY.
