10 An Act relating to the Oklahoma State Bureau of  
11 Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs Control; making an  
12 appropriation; stating purpose; providing lapse  
13 dates; and requiring and prohibiting certain budget  
14 procedures.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma State  
17 Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs Control from any monies not  
18 otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State  
19 Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2023, the sum of Five  
20 Million Three Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$5,300,000.00) or so much  
21 thereof as may be necessary to enhance the operation of the  
22 Marijuana Enforcement Teams.

23 SECTION 2. Appropriations made by this act, not including  
24 appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for  
the fiscal year ending June 30, 2023 (hereafter FY-23), or may be

1 budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2024 (hereafter FY-24).  
2 Funds budgeted for FY-23 may be encumbered only through June 30,  
3 2023, and must be expended by November 15, 2023. Any funds  
4 remaining after November 15, 2023, and not budgeted for FY-24, shall  
5 lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal  
6 year. Funds budgeted for FY-24 may be encumbered only through June  
7 30, 2024. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2024, shall lapse  
8 to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.  
9 These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years  
10 simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-23, and not required to pay  
11 obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-24, after  
12 the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared  
13 and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds  
14 from the FY-23 budget work program and after such revision has been  
15 approved by the Office of Management and Enterprise Services.
