9 An Act relating to commissions and hospitals;
10 amending 72 O.S. 2021, Section 63.10, which relates
11 to establishment of training programs; modifying
12 training programs; updating statutory language;
13 clarifying period of time for certain reimbursements;
14 and declaring an emergency.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 72 O.S. 2021, Section 63.10, is
17 amended to read as follows:

18 Section 63.10. A. The Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs
19 is hereby authorized to establish within ~~said~~ the Department or
20 within any of the institutions operated by the Department training
21 programs to train necessary personnel for the Department or its
22 institutions, or may arrange for programs with any public or private
23 school, entity or institution ~~within this state having available~~
24 ~~facilities for training.~~ Training may occur individually pursuant
 to the Quality Workforce for Oklahoma's Heroes Act. Funds of the

1 Department or its institutions may be used to pay salaries or
2 tuition and subsistence for employees or prospective employees in
3 ~~said~~ the training programs, pursuant to the provisions of subsection
4 B of this section.

5 B. Any employee or prospective employee who, while receiving
6 such training is paid a salary, or for whom tuition and subsistence
7 are furnished shall enter into a contract with the Department prior
8 to receiving any payment for salary, tuition, or subsistence. The
9 contract shall be in accordance with the rules and regulations
10 promulgated by the Oklahoma Veterans Commission and shall include a
11 stipulation that, unless the employee or prospective employee
12 continues in the employ of the Department for a period ~~equivalent~~ of
13 time that is greater than or equal to the length of the training,
14 the employee or prospective employee shall reimburse the Department
15 or institution for the amount of money paid to or for him or her by
16 the Department during the training period.

17 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
18 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
19 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
20 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
