11       An Act relating to career and technology education;  
12       allowing the State Board of Career and Technology  
13       Education to establish certain courses in hydrogen  
14       energy; allowing the Board to consult the Oklahoma  
15       Department of Commerce and the Department of Labor in  
16       establishing courses; providing for codification;  
17       providing an effective date; and declaring an  
18       emergency.

19   BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

20       SECTION 1.       NEW LAW       A new section of law to be codified  
21       in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 14-136 of Title 70, unless there  
22       is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

23       A.   The State Board of Career and Technology Education may  
24       establish courses in the area of hydrogen energy.   The courses may  
25       include but are not limited to the following topics:

      1.   Hydrogen energy basics;

1        2. Hydrogen energy-related equipment manufacturing and  
2 maintenance;

3        3. Hydrogen energy infrastructure; and

4        4. Hydrogen energy safety.

5        B. The State Board of Career and Technology Education may  
6 consult the Oklahoma Department of Commerce and the Department of  
7 Labor in establishing courses that meet the workforce needs of the  
8 hydrogen energy sector in this state.

9        SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2022.

10       SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
11 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby  
12 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
13 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
