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17	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
18	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 62 O.S. 2011, Section 35.3, as
19	last amended by Section 20, Chapter 358, O.S.L. 2013 (62 O.S. Supp.
20	2020, Section 35.3), is amended to read as follows:
21	Section 35.3. As used in the Information Technology
22	Consolidation and Coordination Act:
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1. "Appropriated state agency" means any state agency that
2 receives funding through the annual legislative appropriations
3 process;

2. "Information technology assets" means any equipment or 4 5 interconnected system or subsystem of equipment that is used in the acquisition, storage, manipulation, management, movement, control, 6 display, switching, interchange, transmission, or reception of data 7 or information. The term shall include computers, ancillary 8 9 equipment, software, firmware and similar procedures, services, 10 including support services and consulting services, software development, and related resources, and shall further include 11 telecommunications fiber networks used for conveying electronic 12 13 communication or information systems to multiple physical locations;

14 3. "Information technology position" means a classified or15 unclassified position in the following functional areas:

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a. applications programming,

It being immediately necessary for the preservation 23 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby 24

1	declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
2	be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
