16	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 36 O.S. 2021, Section 302, is
17	amended to read as follows:
18	Section 302. The Insurance Commissioner of the State of
19	Oklahoma this state shall be at least twenty-five (25) years of age
20	and a resident of the State of Oklahoma <u>this state</u> for at least five
21	(5) years, and have had at least five (5) years' experience in the
22	insurance industry in administration, sales, servicing or
23	regulation. The Insurance Commissioner shall not be financially
24	interested, directly or indirectly, in any insurer, agency, or

1	insurance transaction, or other entity that is regulated by the
2	Insurance Department, except as a policyholder or claimant under a
3	policy.
4	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
