AMENDATORY 17 O.S. 2021, Section 13, is 16 amended to read as follows: 17 Section 13. The Corporation Commission shall in the trial of 18 cases and all special proceedings and hearings admit in evidence 19 only such balance sheets, operating statements and other financial 20 exhibits and schedules as shall have been compiled and authenticated 21 by the treasurer or other regularly acting financial officer or 22 employee of such person, firm, association or corporation as may be 23 a party to the proceeding, action or cause pending before or being 24

1	tried by said Commission; provided, that if otherwise relevant and
2	admissible, reports of audit, balance sheets, operating statements
3	and financial exhibits and schedules prepared by employees of said
4	Commission, employees of the Office of the Attorney General, and by
5	public accountants as defined in Section 15.1 et seq. of Title 59 of
6	the Oklahoma Statutes or certified public accountants under the laws
7	of the state, shall be admissible and accepted in evidence in all
8	cases.
9	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
