9 An Act relating to child support; amending 43 O.S.
10 2011, Section 119.1, which relates to legislative
11 review of child support guidelines; requiring review
12 of certain schedule; establishing requirements for
13 certain review; requiring Department of Human
14 Services to promulgate rules for certain purposes;
15 requiring publication of certain information on
16 official websites; and providing an effective date.

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

18 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 43 O.S. 2011, Section 119.1, is
19 amended to read as follows:

20 Section 119.1. A. The child support guidelines and schedule of
21 basic child support obligations shall be reviewed at least once
22 every four (4) years by the Judiciary Committees of the Senate and
23 the House of Representatives to ensure that their application
24 results in the determination of appropriate child support award
25 amounts.

1 B. In conducting the review required pursuant to subsection A
2 of this section, the Judiciary Committees shall:

3 1. Obtain from the Title IV-D Child Support Program in the
4 Department of Human Services economic data on the cost of raising a
5 child, labor market data, case data and case analysis. The
6 Department shall promulgate rules as needed to implement the
7 provisions of this paragraph;

8 2. Provide opportunity for public input from persons including,
9 but not limited to, low-income custodial and noncustodial parents
10 and their representatives; and

11 3. Publish on the official websites of the Senate and the House
12 of Representatives information related to the review including, but
13 not limited to, the membership of the committees conducting the
14 review, the effective date of the guidelines and the date of the
15 next review.

16 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2021.
