9 An Act relating to revenue and taxation; amending 68
10 O.S. 2021, Section 3005.1, which relates to
11 compensation of members of county excise boards;
12 increasing maximum compensation amount based on
13 assessed valuation; updating statutory language; and
14 providing an effective date.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 68 O.S. 2021, Section 3005.1, is
17 amended to read as follows:

18 Section 3005.1. A. A county excise board is hereby created for
19 each county in the state, to be composed of the members of the
20 county board of equalization as created in Section 2861 of this
21 title. The county clerk shall serve as secretary and clerk of ~~said~~
22 the board without additional compensation.

23 B. It shall be unlawful for any member of the county excise
24 board to sell or contract to sell, or to lease or contract to lease,
or to represent any person, firm, corporation or association in the

1 sale or the lease of any machinery, supplies, equipment, material,
2 or other goods, wares, or merchandise to any county or city or town
3 of the county. It shall also be unlawful for any member of the
4 county excise board to serve as employee, official, or attorney for
5 any county or city, or town of the county, or for any such member to
6 represent any taxpayer before such board in any manner, or to use
7 his or her position as a board member to further his or her own
8 interests. It shall also be unlawful for any taxpayer or interested
9 party to employ any member of the county excise board in any matter
10 coming before the board.

11 C. The members of county excise boards in all counties having
12 an assessed valuation of Two Billion Dollars (\$2,000,000,000.00) or
13 more shall receive as compensation an amount not to exceed ~~Seventy-~~
14 ~~five Dollars (\$75.00)~~ One Hundred Twenty-five Dollars (\$125.00) per
15 day. The members of county excise boards in all other counties may
16 receive as compensation an amount not to exceed ~~Fifty Dollars~~
17 ~~(\$50.00)~~ One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) per day, ~~said~~ the amount to
18 be established by the boards.

19 In addition, the members of county excise boards shall be
20 reimbursed for each mile of travel to and from their residences to
21 the place of meeting of the board for each session attended at the
22 rate provided for other county officers. The members of county
23 excise boards shall be also reimbursed for each mile of necessary
24 travel in the performance of their official duties at the same rate.

1 The total number of days in each year for which the members of
2 ~~said~~ the board may be paid shall be as follows:

3 1. In counties having an assessed valuation of Forty Million
4 Dollars (\$40,000,000.00) and less, not to exceed sixty (60) days;

5 2. In counties having an assessed valuation of more than Forty
6 Million Dollars (\$40,000,000.00) and not more than Eighty Million
7 Dollars (\$80,000,000.00), not to exceed sixty-five (65) days;

8 3. In counties having an assessed valuation of more than Eighty
9 Million Dollars (\$80,000,000.00) and not more than Five Hundred
10 Million Dollars (\$500,000,000.00), not to exceed one hundred (100)
11 days; and

12 4. In counties having an assessed valuation of more than Five
13 Hundred Million Dollars (\$500,000,000.00), not to exceed two hundred
14 fifty (250) days.

15 D. Any person violating any of the provisions of this section
16 shall be deemed guilty of a felony, and upon conviction thereof
17 shall be punished by a fine of not less than Two Hundred Dollars
18 (\$200.00) and not more than One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) or by
19 imprisonment in the ~~State Penitentiary~~ custody of the Department of
20 Corrections for not less than six (6) months or more than two (2)
21 years, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

22 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
