16	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
17	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2411.1 of Title 12, unless there
18	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
19	A. This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Act
20	Concerning Interpretation of Oklahoma Insurance Laws".
21	B. A statement or restatement of the law of insurance in any
22	legal treatise, scholarly publication, textbook or other explanatory
23	text shall not constitute the law or public policy of this state and
24	shall not be authoritative if the statement of the law purports to

1	create, eliminate, expand or restrict a cause of action, right or	
2	remedy, or if it conflicts with:	
3	1. The Constitution of the United States or the Constitution of	of
4	the State of Oklahoma;	
5	2. A statute of this state;	
6	3. Case law precedent of this state;	
7	4. Other common law adopted by this state; or	
8	5. Creates or eliminates any cause of action or legal remedy.	
9	SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation	ı
10	of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby	
11	declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and	k
12	be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
