1 entry into licensing agreement; providing maximum licensing fee payment; and providing an effective 2 date. 3 4 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA: 6 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.2, as 7 last amended by Section 1, Chapter 434, O.S.L. 2019 (47 O.S. Supp. 2020, Section 1135.2), is amended to read as follows: 8 9 Section 1135.2 A. The Oklahoma Tax Commission is hereby 10 authorized to design and issue appropriate official special license plates to persons in recognition of their service or awards as 11 12 provided by this section. 13 Special license plates shall not be transferred to any other 14 person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer of 15 ownership and retained. The special license plate may then be used 16 on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been 17 registered for the current year. 18 Special license plates shall be renewed each year by the Tax 19 Commission or a motor license agent. The Tax Commission shall 20 annually notify by mail all persons issued special license plates. 21 The notice shall contain all necessary information and shall contain 22 instructions for the renewal procedure upon presentation to a motor 23 license agent or the Tax Commission. The license plates shall be

issued on a staggered system except for legislative plates and
 amateur radio operator license plates.

3 The Tax Commission is hereby directed to develop and implement a 4 system whereby motor license agents are permitted to accept 5 applications for special license plates authorized under this The motor license agent shall confirm the applicant's 6 section. 7 eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary 8 9 information directly into such system and generate a receipt 10 accordingly. For performance of these duties, motor license agents 11 shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of this title for 12 registration of a motor vehicle. The motor license agent fees for 13 acceptance of applications and renewals shall be paid out of the 14 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund.

B. The special license plates provided by this section are as follows:

17 1. Prisoner of War License Plates - such plates shall be 18 designed for honorably discharged or present members of the United 19 States Armed Forces and civilians who were former prisoners of war 20 held by a foreign country and who can provide proper certification 21 of that status. Such persons may apply for a prisoner of war 22 license plate for no more than two vehicles with each vehicle having 23 a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. The surviving 24 spouse of any deceased former prisoner of war, if the spouse has not

since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is terminated by death, divorce, or annulment, may apply for a prisoner of war license plate for one vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. The fee provided by this section for the special license plate authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to all other registration fees provided by law, except the registration fees levied by Section 1132 of this title;

8 2. National Guard License Plates - such plates shall be
9 designed for active or retired members of the Oklahoma National
10 Guard. Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide
11 proof of eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be
12 required to provide proof of eligibility annually;

3. Air National Guard License Plates - such plates shall be
designed for active or retired members of the Oklahoma Air National
Guard. Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide
proof of eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be
required to provide proof of eligibility annually;

4. United States Armed Forces - such plates shall be designed for active, retired, former or reserve members of the United States Armed Forces, and shall identify which branch of service, and carry the emblem and name of either the Army, Navy, Air Force, Marines or Coast Guard, according to the branch of service to which the member belongs or did belong. Former members who have been dishonorably discharged shall not be eligible for such plates. Persons applying for such license plate must show proof of present or past military service by presenting a valid Uniformed Services Identity Card or the United States Department of Defense Form (DD)214. Retired or former members who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof of eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required to provide proof of eligibility annually;

5. Congressional Medal of Honor Recipient License Plates - such
plates shall be designed for any resident of this state who has been
awarded the Congressional Medal of Honor. Such persons may apply
for a Congressional Medal of Honor recipient license plate for each
vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.
There shall be no registration fee for the issuance of this plate;

13 6. Missing In Action License Plates - such plates shall be 14 designed to honor members of the United States Armed Forces who are 15 missing in action. The spouse of such missing person, if the spouse 16 has not since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is 17 terminated by death, divorce, or annulment, and each parent of the 18 missing person may apply for a missing in action license plate upon 19 presenting proper certification that the person is missing in action 20 and that the person making the application is the qualifying spouse 21 or the parent of the missing person. The qualifying spouse and each 22 parent of the missing person may each apply for the missing in 23 action license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity 24 of one (1) ton or less;

1 7. Purple Heart Recipient License Plates - such plates shall be 2 designed for any resident of this state presenting proper 3 certification from the United States Department of Veterans Affairs 4 or the Armed Forces of the United States certifying that such 5 resident has been awarded the Purple Heart military decoration. Such persons may apply for a Purple Heart recipient license plate 6 7 for vehicles having a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or The surviving spouse of any deceased veteran who has been 8 less. 9 awarded the Purple Heart military decoration, if such spouse has not 10 since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage has been terminated 11 by death, divorce or annulment, may apply for such plate for one 12 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. The 13 license plate created by this paragraph shall be exempt from the fee 14 provided by this section for special license plates;

15 8. Pearl Harbor Survivor License Plates - such plates shall be
16 designed for any resident of this state who can be verified by the
17 United States Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of
18 the United States as being:

- a. a member of the United States Armed Forces on December
 7, 1941,
- b. stationed on December 7, 1941, during the hours of
 7:55 a.m. to 9:45 a.m. Hawaii time at Pearl Harbor,
 the island of Oahu, or offshore at a distance not to
 exceed three (3) miles, and

c. a recipient of an honorable discharge from the United
 States Armed Forces.

3 Such person may apply for a Pearl Harbor Survivor license plate 4 for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or 5 less;

9. Iwo Jima License Plates - such plates shall be designed for
any resident of this state who can be verified by the United States
Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the United
9 States as being:

- a. a member of the United States Armed Forces in February
 of 1945,
- b. stationed in February of 1945 on or in the immediate
 vicinity of the island of Iwo Jima, and
- 14 c. a recipient of an honorable discharge from the United
 15 States Armed Forces.

16 Such person may apply for an Iwo Jima license plate for each 17 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. 18 Such license plate shall have the legend "Oklahoma OK" and shall 19 contain three letters and three numbers. Between the letters and 20 numbers shall be a logo of the flag-raising at Iwo Jima. Below the 21 letters, logo and numbers, the plate shall contain the words "FEB." 22 at the left, "Iwo Jima" in the center and "1945" at the right. Such 23 plates shall not be subject to the design requirements of any other 24 license plates prescribed by law other than the space for the

1 placement of the yearly decals for each succeeding year of 2 registration after the initial issue;

3 10. D-Day Survivor License Plates - such plates shall be
4 designed for any resident of this state who can be verified by the
5 United States Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of
6 the United States as being:

- a member of the United States Armed Forces on June 6, 1944,
- 9 b. a participant in the Allied invasion of the coast of 10 Normandy on June 6, 1944; provided, if such 11 participation cannot be verified by the United States 12 Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of 13 the United States, the Tax Commission may, in its 14 discretion, accept evidence of such participation from 15 the person applying for the license plate, and 16 a recipient of an honorable discharge from the United с. 17 States Armed Forces.

Such person may apply for a D-Day Survivor license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

20 11. Killed in Action License Plates - such plates shall be 21 designed to honor members of the United States Armed Forces who were 22 killed in action. The spouse of the deceased person, if the spouse 23 has not remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is terminated by 24 death, divorce, or annulment, may apply for a killed in action 1 license plate upon presenting proper certification that the person 2 was killed in action and that the person making the application is 3 the qualifying spouse of the deceased person. The qualifying spouse 4 may apply for a killed in action license plate for no more than two 5 vehicles with each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) 6 ton or less. The fee provided by this section for the special 7 license plate authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to 8 all other registration fees provided by law, except the registration 9 fees levied by Section 1132 of this title;

10 12. Gold Star Parents License Plates - such plates shall be 11 designed to honor members of the United States Armed Forces who were 12 killed during a war. The parents of the deceased person may apply 13 for a gold star license plate upon presenting proper certification 14 that the person was killed during a war and that the person making 15 the application is the parent of the deceased person. The parent 16 may apply for a gold star parent license plate for no more than two 17 vehicles with each vehicle having a rated carrying capacity of one 18 (1) ton or less. The fee provided by this section for the special 19 license plate authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to 20 all other registration fees provided by law, except the registration 21 fees levied by Section 1132 of this title;

13. Military Decoration License Plates - such plates shall be
designed for any resident of this state who has been awarded the
Distinguished Service Medal, the Distinguished Service Cross, the

Distinguished Flying Cross, the Bronze Star military decoration or the Silver Star military decoration. Such persons may apply for a military decoration license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

5 14. Vietnam Veteran License Plates - such plates shall be designed for honorably discharged or present members of the United 6 7 States Armed Forces who served in the Vietnam Conflict. Such persons may apply for a Vietnam veteran license plate for each 8 9 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less; 10 15. Police Officer License Plates - such plates shall be 11 designed for any currently employed, reserve or retired municipal 12 police officer or full-time, reserve or retired university police 13 officer certified by the Council on Law Enforcement Education and 14 Training or common education police officer certified by the Council 15 on Law Enforcement Education and Training. Police officers may 16 apply for police officer license plates for vehicles with a rated 17 capacity of one (1) ton or less or for a motorcycle upon proof of 18 employment by or retirement from a municipal, university or common 19 education police department by either an identification card or 20 letter from the chief of the police department or the Oklahoma 21 Police Pension and Retirement Board. Retirees who are eligible for 22 such plates shall provide proof of eligibility upon initial 23 application, but shall not be required to provide proof of 24 eligibility annually. The license plates shall be designed in

1 consultation with municipal police departments of this state; 2 provided, the license plate for motorcycles may be of similar design 3 to the license plate for motor vehicles or may be a new design in 4 order to meet space requirements for a motorcycle license plate; 5 16. World War II Veteran License Plates - such plates shall be designed to honor honorably discharged former members of the United 6 7 States Armed Forces who are residents of this state and who can be verified by the Oklahoma Military Department, the Department of 8 9 Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the United States as having 10 served on federal active duty anytime during the period from 11 September 16, 1940, to December 7, 1945. The former members may 12 apply for a World War II Veteran license plate for vehicles with a 13 rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.

14 The license plate shall have the legend "Oklahoma" and shall 15 contain, in the center of the plate, either the Thunderbird Insignia 16 of the 45th Infantry Division in the prescribed red and gold 17 coloring or the emblem of the Army, Navy, U.S. Army Air Corps, 18 Marines or Coast Guard according to the branch of service to which 19 the member belonged. For the purpose of license plate 20 identification, the plate shall contain four digits, two digits at 21 the left and two digits at the right of the insignia or emblem. 22 Centered on the bottom of the license plate shall be the words 23 "WORLD WAR II";

1 Korean War Veteran License Plates - such plates shall be 17. 2 designed to honor honorably discharged former members of the United 3 States Armed Forces who are residents of this state and who can be 4 verified by the Oklahoma Military Department, the Department of 5 Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the United States as having served on federal active duty anytime during the period from June 6 7 27, 1950, to January 31, 1955, both dates inclusive. The former members may apply for a Korean War Veteran license plate for 8 9 vehicles with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.

10 The license plate shall have the legend "OKLAHOMA" and shall 11 contain, in the center of the plate, either the Thunderbird Insignia 12 of the 45th Infantry Division in the prescribed red and gold 13 coloring or the emblem of the Army, Navy, Air Force, Marines or 14 Coast Guard according to the branch of service to which the member 15 belonged. For the purpose of license plate identification, the 16 plate shall contain four digits, two digits at the left and two 17 digits at the right of the insignia or emblem. Centered on the 18 bottom of the license plate shall be the word "KOREA";

19 18. Municipal Official License Plates - such plates shall be 20 designed for persons elected to a municipal office in this state and 21 shall designate the name of the municipality and the district or 22 ward in which the municipal official serves. The plates shall only 23 be produced upon application;

1 Red Cross Volunteer License Plates - such plates shall be 19. 2 designed to honor American Red Cross volunteers and staff who are 3 residents of this state. Such persons must present an 4 identification card issued by the American Red Cross and bearing a 5 photograph of the person. The license plate shall be designed with the assistance of the American Red Cross and shall have the legend 6 7 "Oklahoma OK!" in the color Pantone 186C Red. Below the legend the symbol of the American Red Cross and no more than three letters and 8 9 three numbers shall be in the color Pantone 186C Red. Below the 10 symbol and letters and numbers shall be the words "American Red 11 Cross" in black. The plates shall not be subject to the design 12 requirements of any other license plates prescribed by law other 13 than the space for the placement of the yearly decals for each 14 succeeding year of registration after the initial issue;

20. Desert Storm License Plates - such plates shall be designed and issued to any honorably discharged or present member of the United States Armed Forces who served in the Persian Gulf Crisis and the Desert Storm operation. Such persons may apply for a Desert Storm license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

21 21. Military Reserve Unit License Plates - such plates shall be 22 designed and issued to any honorably discharged or present member of 23 a reserve unit of the United States Armed Forces. Such persons may

1 apply for a Military Reserve Unit license plate for each vehicle
2 with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

3 22. Oklahoma City Bombing Victims and Survivors License Plates
4 - such plates shall be designed and issued to any victim or survivor
5 of the bombing attack on the Alfred P. Murrah Federal Building in
6 downtown Oklahoma City on April 19, 1995;

7 23. Civil Air Patrol License Plates - such plates shall be
8 designed and issued to any person who is a member of the Civil Air
9 Patrol. Such persons may apply for a Civil Air Patrol license plate
10 for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or
11 less upon proof of membership in the Civil Air Patrol. The license
12 plate shall be designed in consultation with the Civil Air Patrol;

13 24. Ninety-Nines License Plates - such plates shall be designed 14 and issued to members of the Ninety-Nines. Persons applying for 15 such license plate must show proof of membership in the Ninety-16 Nines. The license plates shall be designed in consultation with 17 the Ninety-Nines;

18 25. Combat Infantryman Badge License Plates - such plates shall 19 be designed to honor recipients of the Combat Infantryman Badge. 20 The plate shall have the legend "Oklahoma OK". Below the legend 21 shall be the Combat Infantryman Badge and three numbers. Below the 22 badge and the numbers shall be the words "Combat Infantryman Badge". 23 Such persons may apply for a Combat Infantryman Badge license plate

1 for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or 2 less;

26. Somalia Combat Veterans License Plates - such plates shall
be designed and issued to any honorably discharged or present member
of the United States Armed Forces who saw combat in the United
Nations relief effort. Such persons may apply for a Somalia Combat
Veteran license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying
capacity of one (1) ton or less;

9 27. Police Chaplain License Plates - such plates shall be
10 designed and issued to members of the International Conference of
11 Police Chaplains (ICPC) who have completed the ICPC requirements for
12 basic certification as a police chaplain. The license plates shall
13 be designed in consultation with the ICPC;

14 28. Joint Service Commendation Medal License Plates - such 15 plates shall be designed and issued to any resident of this state 16 who has been awarded the Joint Service Commendation Medal by the 17 United States Secretary of Defense;

18 29. Merchant Marine License Plates - such plates shall be 19 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission 20 by the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs, and issued to any 21 person who during combat was a member of the Merchant Marines as 22 certified by the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs. Such 23 license plate may be issued for each vehicle with a rated carrying 24 capacity of one (1) ton or less; 30. Legislative License Plates - such plates shall be designed
 for persons elected to the Oklahoma Legislature and shall designate
 the house of the Legislature in which the legislator serves and the
 district number;

5 31. Disabled Veterans License Plates - such plates shall be 6 designed for persons presenting proper certification from the United 7 States Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the 8 United States certifying such veteran has a service-connected 9 disability rating of fifty percent (50%) or more, regardless which 10 agency pays the disability benefits, or that such veteran has been 11 awarded a vehicle by the United States government or receives a 12 grant from the United States Department of Veterans Affairs for the 13 purchase of an automobile due to a service-connected disability 14 rating or due to the loss of use of a limb or an eye. Such persons 15 may apply to the Tax Commission for a disabled veterans license 16 plate or to a motor license agent for a regular license plate for no 17 more than two vehicles with each vehicle having a rated carrying 18 capacity of one (1) ton or less. The surviving spouse of any 19 deceased disabled veteran, if the spouse has not since remarried, or 20 if remarried, the remarriage is terminated by death, divorce, or 21 annulment, or a surviving spouse in receipt of Dependency and 22 Indemnity Compensation from the United States Department of Veterans 23 Affairs, may apply for a disabled veterans license plate for one 24 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. The

1 fee provided by this section for the special license plate 2 authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to all other 3 registration fees provided by law, except the registration fees 4 levied by Section 1132 of this title. The total expense of this 5 license plate shall not exceed Five Dollars (\$5.00).

6 If the person qualifies for a disabled veterans license plate 7 and is also eligible for a physically disabled placard under the provisions of Section 15-112 of this title, the person shall be 8 9 eligible to receive a disabled veterans license plate that also 10 displays the international accessibility symbol, which is a stylized 11 human figure in a wheelchair. Upon the death of the disabled veteran with a disabled veterans license plate with the 12 13 international accessibility symbol, the plate shall be returned to 14 the Tax Commission;

15 32. United States Air Force Association License Plates - such 16 plates shall be designed for members of the United States Air Force 17 Association. Persons applying for such license plate must show 18 proof of membership in the Association. The license plates shall be 19 designed in consultation with the Association;

20 33. Oklahoma Military Academy Alumni License Plates - such 21 plates shall be designed and issued to any resident of this state 22 who is an alumnus of the Oklahoma Military Academy. Such persons 23 may apply for an Oklahoma Military Academy Alumnus license plate for 24 each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. The license plates shall be designed in consultation with the
 Oklahoma Military Academy and shall contain the shield of the
 Academy;

4 34. Amateur Radio Operator License Plates - such plates shall 5 be designed and issued to any person, holding a valid operator's license, technician class or better, issued by the Federal 6 7 Communications Commission, and who is also the owner of a motor vehicle currently registered in Oklahoma, in which has been 8 9 installed amateur mobile transmitting and receiving equipment. 10 Eligible persons shall be entitled to two special vehicle 11 identification plates as herein provided. Application for such 12 identification plates shall be on a form prescribed by the Tax 13 Commission and the plates issued to such applicant shall have 14 stamped thereon the word "Oklahoma" and bear the official call 15 letters of the radio station assigned by the Federal Communications 16 Commission to the individual amateur operator thereof. All 17 applications for such plates must be made to the Tax Commission on 18 or before the first day of October of any year for such plates for 19 the following calendar year and must be accompanied by the fee 20 required in this section together with a certificate, or such other 21 evidence as the Tax Commission may require, of proof that applicant 22 has a valid technician class or better amateur operator's license 23 and proof of applicant's ownership of a vehicle in which radio 24 receiving and transmitting equipment is installed. Applicants shall only be entitled to one set of special identification plates in any one (1) year, and such calendar year shall be stamped thereon. The right to such special identification plates herein provided for shall continue until the amateur radio operator's license of the person to whom such plates are issued expires or is revoked;

35. American Legion License Plates - such plates shall be
designed for members of the American Legion. Persons applying for
such license plate must show proof of membership. The license
plates shall be designed in consultation with the American Legion of
Oklahoma;

11 36. Deputy Sheriff License Plates - such plates shall be 12 designed for any currently employed or retired county sheriff or 13 deputy sheriff. County sheriffs or deputy sheriffs may apply for 14 such plates for vehicles with a rated capacity of one (1) ton or 15 less upon proof of employment by or retirement from a county 16 sheriff's office by either an identification card or letter from the 17 county sheriff or a government-sponsored retirement board from which 18 the county sheriff or deputy sheriff may be receiving a pension. 19 Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof of 20 eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required to 21 provide proof of eligibility annually. The license plates shall be 22 designed in consultation with the county sheriff offices of this 23 state;

37. Gold Star Surviving Spouse License Plates - such plates
 shall be designed to honor the surviving spouses and children of
 qualified veterans. As used in this paragraph, "qualified veteran"
 shall mean:

- a. any person honorably discharged from any branch of the
 United States Armed Forces or as a member of the
 Oklahoma National Guard, who died as a direct result
 of the performance of duties for any branch of the
 United States Armed Forces or Oklahoma National Guard
 while on active military duty, or
- b. any person honorably discharged from any branch of the
 United States Armed Forces or as a member of the
 Oklahoma National Guard, who died as a result of
 injury, illness or disease caused by the performance
 of such duties while on active duty, whether the death
 occurred while on active duty or after the honorable
 discharge of such person.

18 The fee provided by this section for the special license plate 19 authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to all other 20 registration fees provided by law, except the registration fees 21 levied by Section 1132 of this title;

38. Korea Defense Service Medal License Plates - such plates
shall be designed and issued to any resident of this state who has
been awarded the Korea Defense Service Medal by the United States

Secretary of Defense. Such persons may apply for a Korea Defense
 Service Medal license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying
 capacity of one (1) ton or less;

39. 180th Infantry License Plates - such plates shall be
designed for members and prior members of the 180th Infantry.

Such person may apply for an Operation 14 Iraqi Freedom Veteran license plate for each vehicle with a rated 15 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less, or for a motorcycle; 16 provided, the license plate for motorcycles may be of similar design 17 to the license plate for motor vehicles or may be a new design in 18 order to meet space requirements for a motorcycle license plate;

41. United States Air Force Academy Alumni License Plates such plates shall be designed and issued to any resident of this
state who is an alumnus of the United States Air Force Academy.
Such persons may apply for a United States Air Force Academy Alumnus
license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one
ton or less;

1 42. Operation Enduring Freedom Veteran License Plate - such 2 plates shall be designed and issued to any honorably discharged or 3 present member of the United States Armed Forces who served in 4 Operation Enduring Freedom on or after September 11, 2001. The 5 license plate shall be designed in consultation with the Military Department of the State of Oklahoma. Such person may apply for an 6 7 Operation Enduring Freedom Veteran license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less, or for a 8 9 motorcycle; provided, the license plate for motorcycles may be of 10 similar design to the license plate for motor vehicles or may be a 11 new design in order to meet space requirements for a motorcycle 12 license plate;

Such persons may apply for a Legion of Merit recipient 13 license plate for vehicles having a rated carrying capacity of one 14 (1) ton or less. The license plate shall be designed in 15 consultation with the Military Department of the State of Oklahoma; 16 1-179th License Plates - such plates shall be designed for 46. 17 members, prior members and members of the household of a member or 18 former member of the 1-179th Infantry. Persons applying for such 19 license plate must obtain and provide proof of their membership 20 association with the 1-179th Infantry Association. The license plate shall include the Combat Action 8 Ribbon earned by the recipient. Such persons may apply for a Combat 9 Action Ribbon Recipient license plate for vehicles having a rated 10 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

11 49. Oklahoma Submarine Veterans License Plate - such plates 12 shall be designed for any resident of this state who is a United 13 States submarine veteran and presents either a Department of Defense 14 form 214 or other documentation certifying such service. Such 15 persons may apply for an Oklahoma Submarine Veterans license plate 16 for vehicles having a rated capacity of one (1) ton or less. The 17 license plate design shall include both gold and silver dolphins to 18 represent both officer and enlisted service members;

19 50. United States Navy Seabees and Civil Engineer Corps License 20 Plate - such plates shall be designed and issued to any honorably 21 discharged or present member of the United States Navy Seabees or 22 Civil Engineer Corps. Such persons may apply for a United States 23 Navy Seabees and Civil Engineer Corps license plate for vehicles 24 having a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. The license plate shall be designed in consultation with the Military
 Department of the State of Oklahoma;

3 51. Combat Action Badge Recipient License Plate - such plates 4 shall be designed to honor recipients of the Combat Action Badge who 5 present proper certification from the United States Army. The license plate shall include the Combat Action Badge earned by the 6 7 recipient. Such persons may apply for a Combat Action Badge Recipient license plate for vehicles having a rated carrying 8 9 capacity of one (1) ton or less, or for a motorcycle; provided, the 10 license plate for motorcycles may be of similar design to the 11 license plate for motor vehicles or may be a new design in order to 12 meet space requirements for a motorcycle license plate;

Iraq Combat Veteran License Plate - such plates shall be 14 designed and issued to any honorably discharged or present member of 15 the United States Armed Forces who saw combat in Operation Iraqi 16 Freedom. Such persons may apply for an Iraq Combat Veteran license 17 plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton 18 or less, or for a motorcycle; provided, the license plate for 19 motorcycles may be of similar design to the license plate for motor 20 vehicles or may be a new design in order to meet space requirements 21 for a motorcycle license plate;

53. Afghanistan Combat Veteran License Plate - such plates
shall be designed and issued to any honorably discharged or present
member of the United States Armed Forces who saw combat in Operation

Enduring Freedom. Such persons may apply for an Afghanistan Combat Veteran license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less, or for a motorcycle; provided, the license plate for motorcycles may be of similar design to the license plate for motor vehicles or may be a new design in order to meet space requirements for a motorcycle license plate; and

7 54. Special Forces Association - such plates shall be designed and issued to any honorably discharged or present member of the Army 8 9 Special Forces qualified and authorized to wear upon the person's 10 United States military uniform the Army Special Forces Tab. Persons 11 applying for the Special Forces Association license plate must 12 provide a copy of the orders awarding the Special Forces Tab or 13 authorizing its wear upon a United States military uniform. The 14 license plate shall be designed in consultation with the Special 15 Forces Association, Chapter 32-50. The Tax Commission shall produce 16 up to two distinct designs for the Special Forces Association 17 license plate. Qualified persons may select one design at the time 18 of application. Section 1135.5 A. The Oklahoma Tax Commission is hereby authorized to design and issue appropriate official special license plates to persons wishing to demonstrate support and provide financial assistance as provided by this section.

Special license plates shall not be transferred to any other person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer of ownership and retained. The special license plate may then be used on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been registered for the current year with a motor license agent.

Special license plates shall be renewed each year by the Tax Commission or a motor license agent, unless authorized by the Tax Commission to be renewed for a period greater than one (1) year. The Tax Commission shall notify by mail all persons issued special license plates. The notice shall contain all necessary information
 and shall contain instructions for the renewal procedure upon
 presentation to a motor license agent or the Tax Commission. The
 license plates shall be issued on a staggered system.

5 The Tax Commission is hereby directed to develop and implement a 6 system whereby motor license agents are permitted to accept 7 applications for special license plates authorized under this The motor license agent shall confirm the applicant's 8 section. 9 eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount 10 specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary 11 information directly into such system and generate a receipt 12 accordingly. For performance of these duties, motor license agents 13 shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of this title for 14 registration of a motor vehicle. The motor license agent fees for 15 acceptance of applications and renewals shall be paid out of the 16 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund.

17 If fewer than one hundred of any type of special license plates 18 authorized prior to January 1, 2004, are issued prior to January 1, 19 2006, the Tax Commission shall discontinue issuance and renewal of 20 that type of special license plate. Any such authorized special 21 license plate registrant shall be allowed to display the license 22 plate upon the designated vehicle until the registration expiration 23 date. After such time the expired special license plate shall be 24 removed from the vehicle.

1 For special license plates authorized on or after July 1, 2004, 2 no special license plates shall be developed or issued by the Tax 3 Commission until the Commission receives one hundred prepaid 4 applications therefor. The prepaid applications must be received by 5 the Tax Commission within one hundred eighty (180) days of the effective date of the authorization or the authority to issue shall 6 7 be null and void. In the event one hundred prepaid applications are not received by the Tax Commission within such prescribed time 8 9 period any payment so received shall be refunded accordingly.

B. The special license plates provided by this section are as follows:

12 1. University or College Supporter License Plate - such plates 13 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate 14 support to any state-supported or private university or college. As 15 provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be 16 apportioned as provided in Section 1104.1 of this title;

17 2. Environmental Awareness License Plate - such plates shall be 18 designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the Tax 19 Commission by the Department of Environmental Quality in 20 consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any 21 person wishing to demonstrate support to implement the statewide 22 general public environmental education program created pursuant to 23 the provisions of the Oklahoma Environmental Quality Code. Such 24 plates shall be designed and issued to any person in any combination

of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for 1 2 personalized license plates. A dealer's license plate issued 3 pursuant to Section 1116.1 or 1128 of this title may be designated 4 an Environmental Awareness License Plate upon payment of the fee 5 imposed by this section and any other registration fees required by 6 the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act. As provided in 7 this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned 8 pursuant to Section 1104.2 of this title;

9 3. Firefighter License Plate - such plates shall be designed 10 for any career or retired firefighter, volunteer or paid. 11 Firefighters may apply for firefighter plates for up to four 12 vehicles with a rated capacity of one (1) ton or less or for a 13 motorcycle upon proof of a fire department membership by either an 14 identification card or letter from the chief of the fire department. 15 Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof of 16 eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required to 17 provide proof of eligibility annually. The surviving spouse of any 18 deceased firefighter, if the spouse has not since remarried, may 19 apply for a firefighter license plate for one vehicle with a rated 20 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less or for a motorcycle upon 21 proof that the deceased firefighter was a member of a fire 22 department by either an identification card or letter from the chief 23 of the fire department. The license plate shall be designed in 24 consultation with the Oklahoma Firefighters Association.

As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
 shall be deposited to the Oklahoma State Firemen's Museum Building &
 Memorial Fund for support of the Oklahoma Firefighters Museum and
 the Oklahoma Fallen and Living Firefighters Memorial;

5 4. Wildlife Conservation License Plate - such plates shall be 6 designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the Tax 7 Commission by the Oklahoma Department of Wildlife Conservation in consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any 8 9 person wishing to demonstrate support for wildlife conservation in 10 this state through the Wildlife Diversity Fund, provided for in Section 3-310 of Title 29 of the Oklahoma Statutes. Such plates may 11 12 be designed and issued to any person as for personalized license 13 plates.

14 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected 15 shall be apportioned pursuant to subsection D of Section 3-310 of 16 Title 29 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

5. Child Abuse Prevention License Plate - such plates shall be designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission by the Office of Child Abuse Prevention in the State Department of Health and the Oklahoma Committee to Prevent Child Abuse, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the prevention of child abuse.

As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
shall be deposited in the Child Abuse Prevention Fund;

1 6. United States Olympic Committee Supporter License Plate -2 such plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to 3 demonstrate support for the United States Olympic Committee. The 4 plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of numbers 5 and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized 6 license plates. The plate shall contain the official United States 7 Olympic Committee logo. The Tax Commission shall be authorized, if 8 necessary, to enter into a licensing agreement with the United 9 States Olympic Committee for any licensing fees which may be 10 required in order to use the United States Olympic Committee logo or 11 design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment of not 12 more than Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) for each license plate 13 issued;

14 7. Oklahoma History License Plate - such plates shall be
15 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate interest in
16 Oklahoma history. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee
17 collected shall be deposited to the Oklahoma Historical Society
18 Revolving Fund to be used for educational purposes;

19 8. Historic Route 66 License Plate - such:

a. vehicle plates shall be designed to honor historic
Route 66, also known as the "Mother Road". As
provided in this section, an amount of the fee
collected for each vehicle license plate shall be
apportioned to the Oklahoma Historical Society

1 Revolving Fund to be distributed to the Route 66 2 Museum located in Clinton, Oklahoma, and 3 b. motorcycle plates shall be designed in consultation 4 with the Oklahoma Route 66 Association, Inc. The 5 Oklahoma Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter into a licensing agreement with the Oklahoma Route 66 6 7 Association, Inc., for any licensing fees which may be required in order to use the Oklahoma Route 66 8 9 Association, Inc., logo or design. The licensing 10 agreement shall provide for a payment to the Oklahoma 11 Route 66 Association, Inc., of not more than Twenty 12 Dollars (\$20.00) for each motorcycle license plate 13 issued;

9. Heart of the Heartland License Plate - such plates shall be
designed and issued to any person wishing to honor the victims of
the terrorist bombing attack on the Alfred P. Murrah Federal
Building in downtown Oklahoma City on April 19, 1995. As provided
in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited
in the Heart of the Heartland Scholarship Fund, as established in
Section 2282 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

21 10. Emergency Medical Technician License Plate - such plates
22 shall be designed and issued to any person who is an emergency
23 medical technician. Such persons may apply for an emergency medical
24 technician license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying

capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of an emergency medical technician's license. The license plate shall be designed in consultation with the state association of emergency medical technicians. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned to the Emergency Medical Personnel Death Benefit Revolving Fund created in Section 1-2505.2 of Title 63 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

8 11. Fight Breast Cancer License Plate - such plates shall be 9 designed to demonstrate support for the prevention and treatment of 10 breast cancer in this state. As provided in this section, an amount 11 of the fee collected shall be apportioned to the Breast Cancer Act 12 Revolving Fund;

13 12. Crime Victims Awareness License Plate - such plates shall 14 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate 15 awareness of and support for victims of crimes. The license plates 16 shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Crime Victims 17 Centre. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected 18 shall be apportioned to the Attorney General's Revolving Fund for 19 the Office of the Attorney General, which is hereby directed to use 20 such funds to contract with a statewide nonprofit organization to 21 provide services to crime victims;

13. Oklahoma Safe Kids Association License Plate - such plates
shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
support and awareness of the Oklahoma Safe Kids Association. The

license plate shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma

 the fee collected shall be deposited in the Children's Hospital Oklahoma Safe Kids Association Revolving Fund to be distributed to

Such plates may be designed and issued 10 to any person as for personalized license plates. As provided in 11 this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned to 12 the OSU Extension Service License Plate Revolving Fund created in 13 Section 1104.4 of this title;

14 15. Agricultural Awareness License Plate - such plates shall be 15 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission, 16 by the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry in 17 consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any 18 person wishing to demonstrate support of the Department's Ag in the 19 Classroom Education Program. As provided in this section, an amount 20 of the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in Section 21 1104.3 of this title;

16. Oklahoma Statehood Centennial License Plate - such plates
shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to commemorate
the centennial of Oklahoma's admission to statehood in 1907. The

1 license plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma 2 Capitol Complex and Centennial Commemoration Commission. As 3 provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be 4 deposited in the Oklahoma Capitol Complex and Centennial 5 Commemoration Commission Revolving Fund created in Section 98.5 of 6 Title 73 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

7 17. Support Education License Plate - such plates shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission 8 9 by the State Department of Education in consultation with the 10 Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any person wishing to 11 demonstrate support for education in this state. All motor license 12 agents shall display a sample of the Support Education License plate 13 in the area of the business accessed by the public. Twenty-three 14 Dollars (\$23.00) of the fee collected shall be apportioned as 15 follows:

- a. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the Education
 Reform Revolving Fund,
- b. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the Higher
 Education Revolving Fund,

The letters "TRP" shall be used in 15 combination with three numbers on either side of the insignia or 16 The color of the letters and numbers shall be brown. emblem. 17 Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof of 18 eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required to 19 provide proof of eligibility annually. The surviving spouse of any 20 deceased retired officer of the Oklahoma Highway Patrol, if the 21 spouse has not since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is 22 terminated by death, divorce, or annulment, may apply for a Retired 23 Oklahoma Highway Patrol Officers license plate. As provided in this

section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited into the
 Law Enforcement Retirement Fund;

3 19. Boy Scouts of America Supporter License Plate - such plates 4 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate 5 support for the Boy Scouts of America. The plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of numbers and letters from one to 6 7 a maximum of seven, as for personalized license plates. The plate 8 shall contain the official Boy Scouts of America logo. The Tax 9 Commission shall be authorized, if necessary, to enter into a 10 licensing agreement with the Boy Scouts of America for any licensing 11 fees which may be required in order to use the Boy Scouts of America 12 logo or design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment 13 to the Boy Scouts of America of not more than Twenty Dollars 14 (\$20.00) for each license plate issued;

15 Urban Forestry and Beautification License Plate - such 20. 16 plates shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the 17 Tax Commission, by the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and 18 Forestry in consultation with nonprofit organizations in this state 19 that develop and operate programs to encourage urban forestry and 20 beautification, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate 21 support of such programs. As provided in this section, an amount of 22 the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in Section 1104.5 23 of this title;

1 21. Oklahoma State Parks Supporter License Plate - such plates 2 shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax 3 Commission by the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department, and 4 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma 5 state parks system. Twenty-three Dollars (\$23.00) of the fee 6 collected shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation 7 Department Revolving Fund. Such money shall be designated for and 8 may only be expended for the support of Oklahoma state parks;

9 22. Adoption Creates Families License Plate - such plates shall 10 be issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support of pregnant 11 women who are committed to placing their children for adoption and 12 wishing to provide assistance to guardians, adoptive parents and 13 other created families to assist in the adoption and placement of 14 children in permanent, safe homes.
