14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
15	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
16	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-233.1 of Title 63, unless
17	there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
18	A. This section shall be known and may be cited as Ava's Law.
19	B. All persons licensed to practice medicine and surgery in
20	this state, or who are Advanced Practice Registered Nurses including
21	but not limited to Certified Nurse-Midwives, and who provide
22	prenatal, delivery, infant care services, and other child or adult
23	health services related to maternal and infant care shall provide to
24	individuals who report to such person that they are pregnant the

1	information provided by the State Department of Health under
2	subsection C of this section.
3	C. The State Department of Health shall compile and make
4	available on its Internet website educational resources on:
5	1. Infant cardiopulmonary resuscitation and basic first aid
6	including contact information for training programs; and
7	2. Cord blood banking and donation.
8	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
