Supp. 2020, Section 1000.21), which relates to 12 membership of the Commission; adding certain members; providing for initial appointment within certain time; providing an effective date; and declaring an 13 emergency. 14 15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA: 16 SECTION 1. 59 O.S. 2011, Section 1000.21, as 17 AMENDATORY amended by Section 2, Chapter 223, O.S.L. 2014 (59 O.S. Supp. 2020, 18 Section 1000.21), is amended to read as follows: 19 20 Section 1000.21. A. 1. There is hereby created the Oklahoma Uniform Building Code Commission within the Construction Industries 21 Board which shall consist of eleven (11) thirteen (13) members, nine 22 23 eleven of whom shall be appointed by the Governor with the advice and consent of the Senate as follows: 24

1	a.	one member who is a general contractor from a
2		statewide organization that represents residential
3		construction,
4	b.	one member who is a general contractor from a
5		statewide organization that represents commercial
6		construction,
7	С.	one member who is a contractor from a statewide
8		organization that represents electrical contractors,
9	d.	one member who is a contractor from a statewide
10		organization that represents plumbing contractors,
11	е.	one member who is a contractor from a statewide
12		organization that represents heating and cooling
13		contractors,
14	f.	one member who is a licensed electrical engineer from
15		a state-recognized professional engineering firm,
16	g.	one member who is a local-level regulator/inspector
17		who is a member of a statewide organization that is
18		exempt from taxation under federal law and designated
19		pursuant to the provisions of the Internal Revenue
20		Code, 26 U.S.C., Section 170(a), who has represented
21		municipalities and had statutory functions for
22		municipalities for at least fifteen (15) years prior

12	2. The members shall be appointed for staggered terms of four	
13	(4) years, beginning July 1, 2009. The initial appointment of the	
14	members added by this act shall be made within ninety (90) days of	
15	the effective date of this act. A full term of office for purposes	
16	of determining term limits provided in subsection C of this section	
17	shall be the completion of a full four-year term of appointment.	
18	B. The remaining two members of the Commission shall be the	
19	State Fire Marshal, or a designee, and an appointee of the	
20	Construction Industries Board.	
21	C. Appointed members shall continue in office until a successor	
22	is appointed by the Governor, notwithstanding the term limitations.	
23	No appointed member shall serve more than two consecutive full four-	
24	year terms; provided, such a member shall be eligible to serve until	

1	a successor is appointed, and such member may be reappointed after a
2	two-year absence from the Commission. The Governor shall fill all
3	vacancies and unexpired terms in the same manner as the original
4	appointment of the member whose position is to be filled. No
5	initial appointment to a term of less than four (4) years or any
6	partial-term appointment to fill a vacancy or unexpired term of
7	another member shall be counted for purposes of determining term
8	limits. An appointed member may be removed by the Governor for
9	cause.

D. Whenever a member of the Commission is absent from more than one-half (1/2) of all meetings of the governing body, regular and special, held within any period of twelve (12) consecutive months, the member shall thereupon cease to hold office by operation of law.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2021.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
