10 An Act relating to pharmacy; amending 59 O.S. 2011,  
11 Section 353.30, as amended by Section 9, Chapter 106,  
12 O.S.L. 2018 (59 O.S. Supp. 2020, Section 353.30),  
13 which relates to administration of immunizations and  
14 therapeutic injections; broadening authority of  
15 pharmacist to administer immunizations; and declaring  
16 an emergency.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 59 O.S. 2011, Section 353.30, as  
18 amended by Section 9, Chapter 106, O.S.L. 2018 (59 O.S. Supp. 2020,  
19 Section 353.30), is amended to read as follows:

20 Section 353.30. A. The use of agreements in the practice of  
21 pharmacy shall be acceptable within the rules promulgated by the  
22 State Board of Pharmacy and in consultation with the State Board of  
23 Medical Licensure and Supervision and the State Board of Osteopathic  
24 Examiners.

1 B. The Board shall develop and prepare permanent rules relating  
2 to training requirements and administration of immunizations and  
3 therapeutic injections in consultation within the State Board of  
4 Medical Licensure and Supervision and the State Board of Osteopathic  
5 Examiners.

6 C. A pharmacist who has completed a requisite course of  
7 training as approved by the Board in consultation with the State  
8 Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision and the State Board of  
9 Osteopathic Examiners may administer ~~immunizations and~~ therapeutic  
10 injections on orders from a licensed prescriber, and may administer  
11 immunizations that have been approved or authorized by the Food and  
12 Drug Administration without a patient-specific prescription,  
13 standing order or similar arrangement.

14 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
15 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby  
16 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
17 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
