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14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:		
15	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 5, Chapter 40, O.S.L. 2020		
16	(59 O.S. Supp. 2020, Section 3040.5), is amended to read as follows:		
17	Section 3040.5. A. There is hereby created, to continue until		
18	July 1, 2026, in accordance with the provisions of the Oklahoma		
19	Sunset Law, an Advisory Committee on Midwifery, which shall consist		
20	of seven (7) voting members to be appointed by the State		
21	Commissioner of Health as follows:		
22	1. Three licensed midwives, each of whom has at least three (3)		
23	years of experience in the practice of midwifery;		
24	2. One Certified Nurse-Midwife;		

3. One physician who is certified by a national professional
 organization of physicians that certifies obstetricians and
 gynecologists and supports the practice of midwifery;

4 4. One physician who is certified by a national professional
5 organization of physicians that certifies family practitioners or
6 pediatricians and supports the practice of midwifery; and

5. One member of the general public who is not practicing or
trained in a health care profession, and who is a parent with at
least one child born with the assistance of a licensed midwife or a
Certified Nurse-Midwife.

11 в. Members of the Committee shall serve for staggered terms of 12 six (6) years. The terms of three members shall expire on January 31 of each odd numbered year be divided into three classes. The 13 initial terms of the first class shall expire on January 31, 2023, 14 15 and subsequent terms shall expire on January 31 of each sixth year 16 thereafter. The initial terms of the second class shall expire on January 31, 2025, and subsequent terms shall expire on January 31 of 17 each sixth year thereafter. The initial terms of the third class 18 shall expire on January 31, 2027, and subsequent terms shall expire 19 on January 31 of each sixth year thereafter. Members shall serve 20 until a qualified successor has been duly appointed. 21 The Commissioner shall fill a vacancy no later than sixty (60) days from 22 the date the vacancy occurs. No person shall be appointed to serve 23 more than two (2) consecutive terms. 24

1 C. The Committee shall annually elect a chair and vice-chair 2 from among its members. 3 D. The Committee shall meet at least semiannually and at any other time at the call of the chair or the Commissioner. 4 The Committee shall meet in accordance with the Oklahoma 5 Ε. 6 Open Meeting Act. 7 A majority of the members of the Committee including at F. least two licensed midwives, shall constitute a quorum for the 8 9 conduct of Committee business. 9 2. The Committee shall review and make recommendations to the10 Commissioner on all applications for licensure.

3. The Committee shall assist and advise the Commissioner in all hearings related to the enforcement of Shepherd's Law. The Committee shall review all complaints and make recommendations to the Commissioner on appropriate disciplinary action including, but not limited to, administrative fines, license revocation and license suspension.

17 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2021.
