## COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to memorial bridge and highway designations; designating the William Charles "Charley" Coen Memorial Highway; designating the Bud Martin Memorial Bridge; designating the Private Robert "Bob" Clark Memorial Bridge; designating the President Donald J. Trump Highway; providing for funding of signage; designating the Speaker Pro Tempore Jim R. Glover Memorial Highway; designating the Medal of Honor Recipient Sergeant John R. Crews Memorial Bridge; designating the Trooper J.C. Magar Memorial Highway; designating the Congressional Medal of Honor Recipient Edward A. DeVore, Jr. Memorial Bridge; designating the Navy Cross Recipient CPL Russell Keck Memorial Highway; designating the TSgt Marshal D. Roberts Memorial Highway; designating the Sweetwater Veterans Memorial Highway; designating the SSGT Cecil Wellman Memorial Bridge; designating the Officer Michael Bruce Keen Memorial Bridge; designating the Tommy Wayne Haley Memorial Bridge; designating the MSGT Michael Werdehoff Vietnam MIA Memorial Bridge; designating the SP4 Alfred Dean Hildebrand Memorial Highway; designating the James Amos Callins Memorial Bridge; designating the Lieutenant Eugene Smith Memorial Highway; requiring certain markers; providing for codification;

1 providing for noncodification; and providing an effective date. 2 3 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA: 5 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.308 of Title 69, unless 6 7 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: The section of U.S. Highway 64 beginning at the western 8 9 municipal limits of the town of Buffalo in Harper County extending 10 to N1860 Road shall be designated as the "William Charles "Charley" 11 Coen Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall 12 cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on 13 the highway. A new section of law to be codified SECTION 2. 14 NEW LAW 15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.309 of Title 69, unless 16 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: The bridge over Turkey Creek in Woodward County approximately 17 two (2) miles east of the Ellis and Woodward County border on 18 Highway 15 shall be designated as the "Bud Martin Memorial Bridge". 19 20 The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the bridge. 21 SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified 22 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.310 of Title 69, unless 23 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 24

The bridge over the Cimarron River on Highway 15 approximately thirteen (13) miles north of Boise City shall be designated as the "Private Robert "Bob" Clark Memorial Bridge". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the bridge.

SECTION 4. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.311 of Title 69, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the section of State Highway 287 beginning at the municipal limits of Boise City extending southeast to the Oklahoma-Texas border in Cimarron County shall be designated as the "President Donald J. Trump Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the highway.

SECTION 5. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

The cost associated with signage related to Section 4 of this act shall be paid by the Senate and House of Representatives authors and coauthors of this act.

SECTION 6. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.312 of Title 69, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The section of State Highway 17 beginning at the east municipal limits of Elgin extending to the intersection with NE Miller Street

1 in Comanche County shall be designated as the "Speaker Pro Tempore 2 Jim R. Glover Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation 3 shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the highway. 4 5 SECTION 7. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.313 of Title 69, unless 6 7 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: The bridge over Western Avenue on Interstate 240 within the 8 9 municipal limits of Oklahoma City shall be designated as the "Medal 10 of Honor Recipient Sergeant John R. Crews Memorial Bridge". Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers 11 12 bearing that name to be placed on the bridge. SECTION 8. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified 13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.314 of Title 69, unless 14 15 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: The portion of State Highway 271 beginning south of the 16 municipal limits of Hugo and ending north of the municipal limits of 17 Grant shall be designated as the "Trooper J.C. Magar Memorial 18 Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable 19 permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the highway. 20 SECTION 9. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified 21 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.315 of Title 69, unless 22 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 23

1 The bridge over Coal Creek located on US Route 75 Business 2 within the municipal limits of Henryetta shall be designated as the 3 "Congressional Medal of Honor Recipient Edward A. DeVore, Jr. Memorial Bridge". The Department of Transportation shall cause 4 5 suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the 6 bridge. A new section of law to be codified 7 SECTION 10. NEW LAW in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.316 of Title 69, unless 8

there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The portion of State Highway 56 beginning just west of North Wood Drive extending approximately one (1) mile west through the municipal limits of Okmulgee shall be designated as the "Navy Cross Recipient CPL Russell Keck Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the highway.

SECTION 11. A new section of law to be codified NEW LAW in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.317 of Title 69, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The section of State Highway 20 beginning at the junction of State Highway 20 and N 145th E Avenue in Owasso extending east to the junction of State Highway 20 and S 4080 Road in Rogers County shall be designated as the "TSgt Marshal D. Roberts Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the highway.

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SECTION 12. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.318 of Title 69, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The section of State Highway 30 beginning at the southern municipal limits of the town of Sweetwater in Beckham County extending south to the intersection of State Highway 30 and County Road 1140 in Beckham County shall be designated as the "Sweetwater Veterans Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the highway.

SECTION 13. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.319 of Title 69, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The bridge over Interstate 35 on State Highway 74 within the municipal limits of Purcell in McClain County shall be designated as the "SSGT Cecil Wellman Memorial Bridge". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the bridge.

SECTION 14. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.320 of Title 69, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The bridge over Little Skin Bayou on U.S. Highway 64 in Sequoyah County shall be designated as the "Officer Michael Bruce Keen Memorial Bridge". The Department of Transportation shall cause

suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the bridge.

SECTION 15. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.321 of Title 69, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The bridge over Chouteau Creek on U.S. Highway 77 in Cleveland County shall be designated as the "Tommy Wayne Haley Memorial Bridge". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the bridge.

SECTION 16. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.322 of Title 69, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The bridge located on Interstate 44 over State Highway 49 within Comanche County shall be designated as the "MSGT Michael Werdehoff Vietnam MIA Memorial Bridge". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the bridge.

SECTION 17. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.323 of Title 69, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The portion of State Highway 30 beginning at the northern municipal limits of the town of Sweetwater extending north to the intersection of State Highway 30 and E 1060 Road in Roger Mills County shall be designated as the "SP4 Alfred Dean Hildebrand"

Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the

SECTION 18. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.324 of Title 69, unless

there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The bridge located on State Highway 34 over the Salt Fork of the Red River, south of Mangum, in Greer County shall be designated as the "James Amos Callins Memorial Bridge". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the bridge.

SECTION 19. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.325 of Title 69, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The portion of State Highway 51B beginning one half mile west of the western municipal limits of Porter and ending one half mile east of the eastern municipal limits of Porter shall be designated as the "Lieutenant Eugene Smith Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the highway.

SECTION 20. This act shall become effective November 1, 2021.
