

1 Training (CLEET), offer courses of study for law enforcement
2 certification, basic peace officer certification academies and other
3 law-enforcement-related training. Commissioned and noncommissioned
4 individuals and those individuals appointed or not appointed by a
5 law enforcement agency may attend the courses or training offered by
6 the technology center school or higher education institution. CLEET
7 shall vote to approve or deny an application to offer courses or
8 training offered pursuant to this section. Notice of denial of
9 application shall include a clear and concise statement for which
10 the denial is based. CLEET may authorize up to two new entities
11 each year to offer courses or training. Courses and training
12 offered by authorized entities shall consist of actual classroom
13 training at each entity location. All non-classroom training shall
14 be provided at the CLEET training facility, unless approved
15 otherwise by CLEET.

16 B. Any courses or training offered pursuant to this section
17 shall meet minimum standards established for peace officers as set
18 forth in Section 3311 of ~~Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes~~ this
19 title and meet all applicable eligibility requirements for students
20 to receive benefits pursuant to any of the federal G.I. bills. ~~All~~
21 Prior to enrollment, all participants in any courses or training
22 offered pursuant to this section shall be required to submit all
23 background investigation requirements as set forth in Section 3311
24 of ~~Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes~~ this title. Costs associated

1 with the required background investigation requirements shall be the
2 responsibility of the student.

3 C. Any state-supported technology center school in the State of
4 Oklahoma operating under the State Board of Career and Technology
5 Education or any higher education institution in this state shall be
6 authorized to set and administer their own rates for tuition and
7 fees for courses or training offered pursuant to this section.

8 D. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, any materials
9 and records provided by CLEET to any institution of higher education
10 or state-supported technology center school conducting a basic law
11 enforcement training shall remain the property of CLEET and retain
12 confidential status and shall not be released except under the
13 conditions contained in Section 24A.8 of Title 51 of the Oklahoma
14 Statutes. In addition, any materials and records provided by any
15 institution of higher education or state-supported technology center
16 school conducting basic law enforcement training to CLEET shall be
17 subject to these same limitations on release. Such materials and
18 records include, but are not limited to, all records maintained
19 pursuant to Section 3311 of this title and records relating to any
20 employed or certified full-time officer, reserve officer, retired
21 officer or other person; teacher lesson plans, tests and other
22 teaching materials; and personal communications concerning
23 individual students except under the circumstances set forth in
24 Section 24A.8 of Title 51 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2021.
