10	COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE
11	An Act relating to elections; amending 26 O.S. 2011,
12	Sections 7-108 and 16-111, which relate to electioneering; modifying prohibited activities at
13	<pre>polling place or voting site; defining terms; modifying elements of certain misdemeanor offense;</pre>
14	and providing an effective date.

17	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
18	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 26 O.S. 2011, Section 7-108, is
19	amended to read as follows:
20	Section 7-108. A. No person shall be allowed to electioneer
21	within three hundred (300) feet of any ballot box an entrance to a
22	polling place or in-person absentee voting site or a person who is
23	standing in line to vote outside the polling place or voting site
24	while an election is in progress , nor shall any . No person or

persons, except election officials, voters registered and voting at the polling place or voting site, minor children or dependents accompanying such voters and other persons authorized by law, shall be allowed inside the election enclosure or within fifty (50) feet of any ballot box an entrance to a polling place or in-person absentee voting site while an election is in progress. No printed material other than that provided by the election board shall be publicly placed or exposed within three hundred (300) feet of any ballot box, an entrance to a polling place or in-person absentee voting site while an election is in progress.

B. For purposes of this title:

- 1. "Electioneering" means:
 - a. advocating directly for or against a candidate or

 question that is on the ballot at the election, either

 verbally or with visual materials, signs or clothing,

 or
 - b. collecting signatures for a petition to place an issue or question on a future ballot; and
- 2. "Election enclosure" means the areas of a polling place or in-person absentee voting site where voters sign the precinct registry and are issued ballots, where voting booths are located, where a voting device or ballot box is located, and any room, hallway or other space wherein such activities take place.

1	SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 26 O.S. 2011, Section 16-111, is
2	amended to read as follows:
3	Section 16-111. Any person who electioneers within three
4	hundred (300) feet of any ballot box an entrance to a polling place
5	or in-person absentee voting site or a person who is standing in
6	line to vote outside the polling place or voting site while an
7	election is in progress, and any person except election officials,
8	voters registered and voting at the polling place or voting site,
9	minor children or dependents accompanying such voters and other
10	persons authorized by law who remains within fifty (50) feet of any
11	ballot box an entrance to a polling place or in-person absentee
12	voting site while an election is in progress shall be deemed guilty
13	of a misdemeanor.
14	SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2021.
